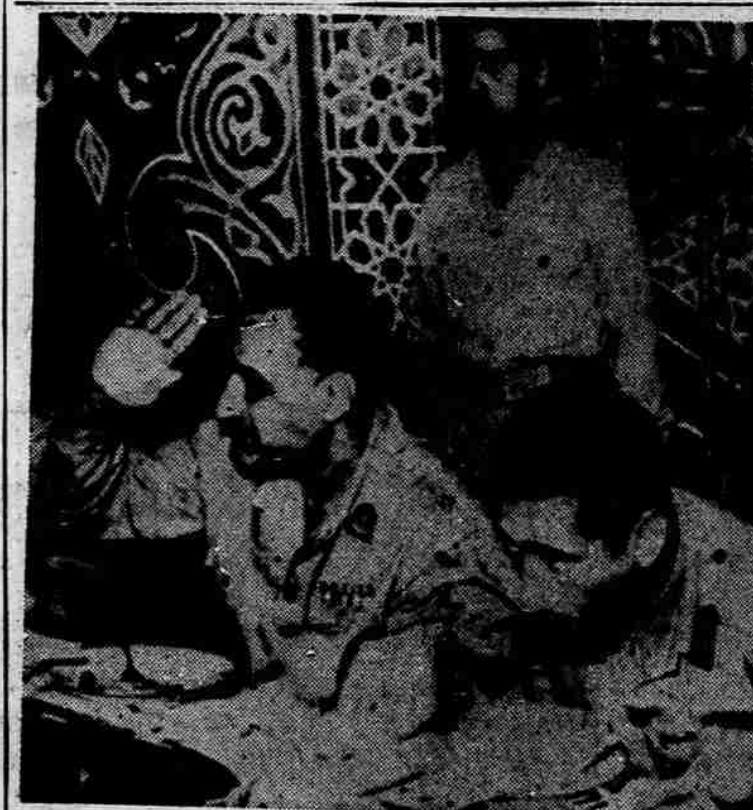

Mate Drinks. Insults
Wife Before Company

Young persons' attitudes toward marriage are seriously affected by the pattern for family life which they see at home. That is true of the young girl whose mother writes:

"I have a 14-year-old daughter. My husband makes good money, but he is a drunkard. I have worked ever since I was married and tried to make a happy home for my daughter. My husband goes to the bar every day and won't come home until the bar closes. If company comes before he leaves for the bar, he insults me in front of them. When I am sick, he won't send for a doctor but tells me to go home to my mother. I have tried to have my pastor talk to him but he is never at home. Now I am willing to stop trying and not hold on to something that was never mine anyway. But, before I do, I would like your advice." (A) You seem to have tried the best you could to make a go of your marriage. But a successful marriage depends upon the cooperation of both husband and wife. Without this cooperation, there is little hope that the marriage can work out satisfactorily.

Your daughter is at an impressionable age. The kind of home life she sees will distort her whole attitude toward marriage and toward life in general. It would be far better for her not to be with her father, as he behaves, than to be with him.

You do not have to break up your marriage permanently until you are sure there is no other solution to the problem. Why

not ask your minister to help you to get a legal separation? Then, if things do not improve, you could later sue for a divorce if you wanted to be free from your husband.

As he is making good money, and has enough for daily drinking, make sure the court grants you adequate amounts to support your daughter and the home. You should not have to work as you have been doing ever since your marriage.

Your husband has shirked his responsibilities to your daughter and you have had to do everything for her. You should not also have to earn money to support her. Make this situation clear to the judge when you apply for a separation from your husband.

Better Light To Curb Drinking by Juveniles

Hilo, T. H.—(U.P.)—A highly sensitive light meter had been adopted to establish a minimum lighting standard for all the city's drinking places.

It was estimated that about 50 per cent of liquor violations resulted from drinking by juveniles. In order to curb the practice, city authorities decided to set up better light facilities so liquor commission inspectors could spot youngsters.

The light meter is designed to record the candlepower of illumination to a fine-hair degree of accuracy.

Sand Dredged From Shoals in Columbia

Portland — (U.P.) — Some 3,250,000 cubic yards of sand were dredged from shoals in the Columbia river during the dredging season just ended, according to Col. James U. Moorhead, Portland district engineer.

Hopper dredges participating were the Biddle, Russell and Pacific. The Biddle was to be dispatched to San Francisco. The Pacific will continue to work in the river until Christmas.

In addition, the pipeline dredge Multnomah, now working near Westport, has removed more than 1,400,000 cubic yards from the channel, and the Port of Portland dredge Clackamas has removed some 1,200,000 cubic yards of sand from the Kalama, Wash., bar since August.

Amoeba Weight Gives Clue To Cell Growth

Berkeley, Calif. — (U.P.) — The weight of an amoeba, a minute single-celled animal, has given a clue to cell growth which may be helpful in solving the cancer riddle, according to experiments made at the University of California.

David M. Prescott, a Ph.D. candidate, reported that he has observed that cell division occurs in an amoeba some time after it has reached its maximum weight. This runs contrary to previous theories that the size of the cell was the trigger that set off the process of cell division.

Prescott's findings, combined with other research, may be a key in solving the cancer problem, for scientists have found that cancer occurs when the process of cell division goes haywire and cell populations increase beyond normal size.

Weighing an amoeba during its growth cycle was quite a task because it is so small that it takes around 25 hundred million of them to weigh one ounce. Also, the tiny animals die when exposed to the air, so Prescott made all his weighings "under water" by measuring pressure increase as the animal grew.
