Recommend Parakeet Quarantine in State

Portland (U.P.)—The Oregon State Board of Health today recommended an "indefinite" quarantine for 1400 parakeets in the state. One of them was found to be infected with psittacosis and may have transmitted the disease to the others, the board said.

The 1400 birds are held by health authorities in Marion, Lane, Linn and Douglas counties. They were seized from stores and pet shops and from "V and W Enterprises" which had previously sold at least 2000 of the psittacine birds in the state.

Three operators of the V and W firm were given suspended fines and jail sentences in Roseburg last week on charges of illegally importing psittacine birds into the state and failing to keep records available for inspection by health authorities.
