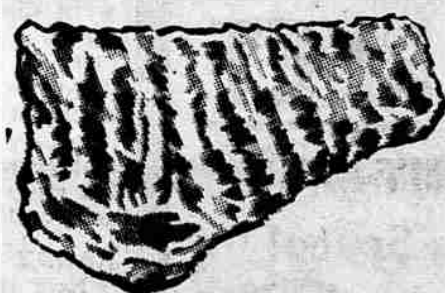

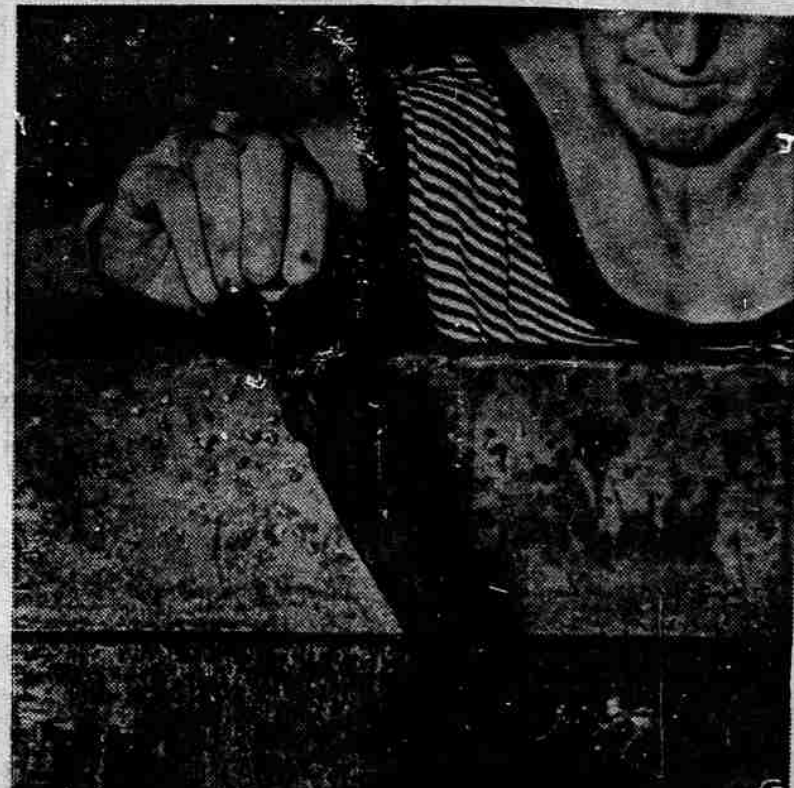

French Ask Delay in Ratification Debate

Paris — (U.P.)—The powerful Foreign Affairs Committee of the National Assembly asked today that debate on ratification of the Western European Union be postponed a week until Dec. 20. The Assembly's steering committee, including committee chairmen and representatives of all major groups in the legislature, will rule on the Foreign Affairs Committee's request tomorrow.

Premier Pierre Mendes-France who reported to the foreign affairs group today on his recent visit to the United States, had wanted to get the ratification debate under way on schedule Dec. 14. Informed sources said he probably will accept the week's postponement, but they predicted he will demand a confidence vote if there is any further stalling on the issue.

Robber Gets Tougher Jolt Second Time

Kitchener, Ont. — (U.P.)—Gerald Hopt, 18, was freed on probation Tuesday after service station owner William Joseph caught him rifling his till. Ten hours later he was back in court for attempting to rob the same service station. This time he was sentenced to 18 months in the reformatory.

Movie May Show Neuberger's Life

Portland — (U.P.)—Motion picture producer Walter Wanger said here yesterday he is planning a movie based on the lives of Democratic Senator-elect Richard L. Neuberger and his wife, Maurine.

Wanger, who flew here from Hollywood yesterday to confer with Neuberger and his wife, said the movie would be built around Neuberger's recently-released book, "Adventures in Politics."

"I believe I can make an exciting and entertaining motion picture out of the material in this book," Wanger said. "I want to make a strong picture for the 1956 elections that will be non-partisan but help the American people to think about government."

Wanger said the film would be "one of the most important" in his career, but that it must have a light touch.

The picture would not be produced immediately, but would be released during the 1956 election campaign.

Wanger said he would like to star a husband and wife team as the Neubergers, although he said he would "not embarrass" them by using the Neuberger name or their identical life story.

Boston — (U.P.)—Edward R. Tadeo was denied a divorce on the grounds he offered. He said his wife persisted in staying out and playing poker "with the girls" until 2 a.m.
