Klamath TV Work Due Soon

Klamath Falls—(U.P.)—W. D. Miller, owner-operator of Radio Station KFJL, Klamath Falls, and KWIN, Ashland, said he would begin construction of Oregon's fifth television station "as soon as possible."

The Federal Communications Commission has authorized Miller to proceed with construction of KFJL-TV on Channel Two.

Miller said "unforeseen elements such as weather and equipment delivery would preclude any specific target day announcement."

He said he would purchase from General Electric a five kilowatt television transmitter and a three-bay antenna, plus complete studio and film equipment for local, network, and film programming.

KFJL-TV will operate on Oregon's lowest channel and highest antenna. Engineering estimates indicate the station will effectively cover the northern California-Southern Oregon area, including the Klamath basin and the Rogue river valley.

Three Cars Involved In Highway Accident

Three cars were involved in an accident which occurred Friday at about 8:45 p.m. on Highway 99 near Birdseye creek, according to state police.

Officers said that Henry Charles Diess, Rogue River, was in one car and was pulling another, driven by June Diess, Rogue River, from a ditch beside the highway, when a third car, driven by William E. Statum, Grants Pass, collided with the others.

No injuries were reported, and damage was said not to have been extensive.

THE NERVE OF THE FAMILY DOCTOR

Last June, at the annual meeting of the American Medical Association in San Francisco the chairman of the Section on the General Practice, Dr. E. W. Ewens, M. D., addressed the doctors on the subject of "Hospital privileges for General Practitioners."

The speaker told of the building of a new hospital which was to be an open hospital for the general practitioners of the community, that is, the family physicians were to be privileged to treat their patients in the hospital. So many of the physicians practicing in the community had worked hard to raise funds for the hospital.

Heh, heh. When the hospital formed its staff, the general practitioner, poor boob, was told he could not do the work he felt he was capable of performing. Well, what did the poor boob expect?

A family physician has a nerve to try to compete for public patronage, in these days of "closed" staff hospitals. He should realize that hospitals are for people with plenty of jack, not for the lowly peasants who employ general practitioners.
