The increasing frequency of queries about the amount of cholesterol a person gets from this or that food indicates that the tricksters are catering to customers who have learned from Aunt Polly or Kitty Korner magazine that cholesterol

may be deposited in the arteries unless... Now, some readers are aware that I appreciate the value of nice soft arteries. In fact I have been taking medicine for the past twenty years to keep mine that way—a good dose of some salts before breakfast every morning.

Drs. Moon and Rhinehart of the Medical School, U. C., concluded from five years of study of arteries of persons ranging in age from infancy to 90 years, some of whom had died of heart disease, some from accident, that cholesterol is deposited in the artery wall as a consequence of disease, not as the cause of it.

At about the same time Dr. Goffman, working in another laboratory of the same university insisted that what he called giant cholesterol molecules form in the artery walls at the onset of hardening of the arteries.

This difference of the experts or authorities reminds me of the controversy over the significance of calcium deposits in or calcification of arteries and joints.

The old timers noticed calcium deposits or calcification of arteries or joints of individuals who had for years had hardened arteries or rheumatoid, and being ignorant of pathology, jumped to the conclusion that the calcium caused the arteriosclerosis or the rheumatoid.

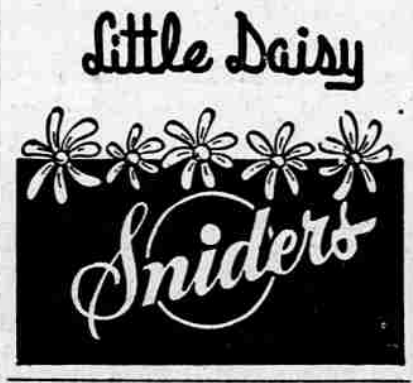
From the newer knowledge of pathology and of nutrition acquired in the last 40 years, we

know today, first, that most Americans do not get enough calcium from their food to maintain good nutrition and good health, and, second, that when calcium is deposited in an artery wall or in the tissues of the joints it is in consequence of the pathological process in tissues which we know as degeneration. Degeneration occurs when the body can no longer produce new cells to replace the cells that wear out and die by millions every day. In place of new cells which function in place of the worn-out or dead cells, the body can now only patch up the degenerated tissues or organs with inert fibrous (scar) tissue or a kind of plaster of Paris—calcification.

Next time your racketeer tries to frighten you about "calcium deposits" causing hardening of the arteries—oh, well, of course you dare not challenge him, but in case your "leading" quack ever does hand you that line the great Dr. Osler's teaching ought to comfort you. In his famous Practice Osler said:
