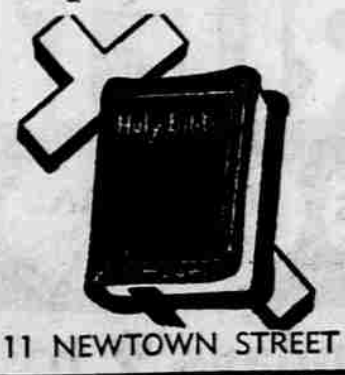
Phillips Scion Found Near Las Vegas, Nev.
