

New Super Highway Opens in Washington

Vancouver, Wash. — (U.P.) — A new section of super Evergreen highway between Vancouver and Camas, Wash., was to be opened here today after completion of an \$860,845 Washington highway project.

The section stretches for more than five miles from the eastern city limits of Vancouver to Fishers. It is 24 feet wide but is graded for an eventual four lanes. It eliminates 13 curves on the old route. It allows complete through traffic by use of channelized access connections.

Completion of the work to Camas is expected to begin by April 1.

Chocolate Nut Shortbread

Fine eating! Fine for giving! Everybody loves shortbread! Here's how to make chocolate nut shortbread like this:

- 1 cup butter or margarine
- 1½ cups confectioners' sugar
- 2¼ cups flour
- 2 squares unsweetened chocolate
- ¼ cup chopped walnuts

Melt the chocolate over hot water and beat into the butter or margarine. Add the sugar, then the flour and mix well. Add the walnut meats, then roll and chill in the refrigerator until very firm. Remove and slice for cookies. Place on a baking sheet but before placing in the oven, press a walnut half lightly in the center of each cookie. Bake at 325 degrees for 20 minutes, then remove and let cool. Makes about 2½ dozen.

Curried Casserole

Quick and very good, this casserole makes eight servings. Combine one 10½ ounce can condensed undiluted cream of mushroom soup and a No. 2 can of small white onions (or fix and cook two cups small white onions). Season with three fourths teaspoon curry powder; top with buttered crumbs. Bake 30 minutes in a moderate oven, 375 degrees.

Spiced Grapefruit

Spiced and broiled fresh grapefruit! Cut grapefruit in half as usual. Remove seeds. Separate sections from rind and membrane. Cut out core. Sprinkle with brown sugar and ground cinnamon mixture, using one teaspoon ground cinnamon for one cup firmly packed brown sugar. Place under broiler to brown and for sugar to melt.

Christmas Peaches

Delectable with any roast or poultry. Plan to chill 24 hours for "ripening." Drain syrup from a No. 2½ (large) can of peach halves. Add one-fourth cup cider vinegar, one-third cup brown sugar, one-half teaspoon each whole allspice and cloves tied in a bag and one stick whole cinnamon. Heat to boiling point and boil three minutes. Add peaches. Cover. Chill 24 hours before serving.

Holiday Salad

Arrange sections of pink grapefruit and avocado slices on beds of head lettuce. Serve with a mixture of one-fourth cup fresh lemon juice, one-half cup salad oil, one-half teaspoon salt, one-fourth teaspoon whole celery seed, one dash ground black

pepper and a dash of garlic powder.

Stuffed Dates

Remove pits from fresh ripe dates. Stuff cavity with pecan halves, filberts or blanched toasted almonds. Roll in cinnamon sugar using one teaspoon ground cinnamon to one-fourth cup sugar.

Striped Salad Balls

The children will enjoy making and eating these. Core unpeeled red apples and cut slices lengthwise; then press slices into seasoned cottage cheese balls. Garnish with greens.

So many things to do! Solve problem of easy dinner by planning generous casserole of California large dry lima beans. If you add some meat to the limas as they cook, you'll have only a tossed salad and fruit dessert to round out the meal. Handy meats are sliced frankfurters or any of the canned ham products, diced.

Jewel-Toned Salad

Mold fresh orange and cranberry relish, large chunks of walnuts and thinly sliced celery in cherry flavored gelatin for a beautiful jewel-toned salad. For a party, chill it in a ring mold. Offer French dressing if served as salad; tinted whipped cream if offered as dessert.

Holiday Rice

Brown rice cooked in consommé, then tossed with buttered and diced roasted almonds, finely chopped parsley and pimiento is Christmasy looking, very tasty.

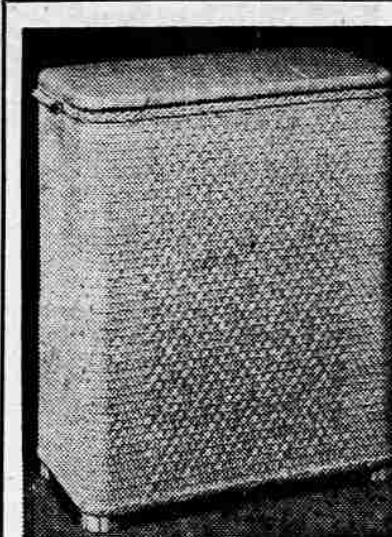

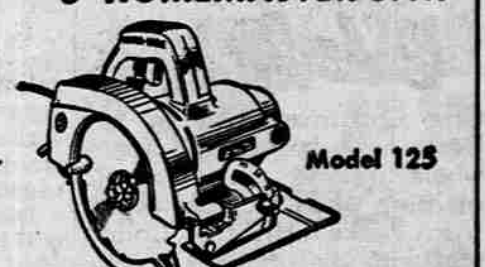
