Three Youths Killed In Salem Area Mishap

Salem — (U.P.) — Three youths were killed Sunday when their car went out of control on a curve six miles east of Salem and crashed into an oak tree.

Dead are Charlotte Lennon, 18, Salem; Bryant Foster, 20, Albany; and James Mundorf, 19, also of Albany.

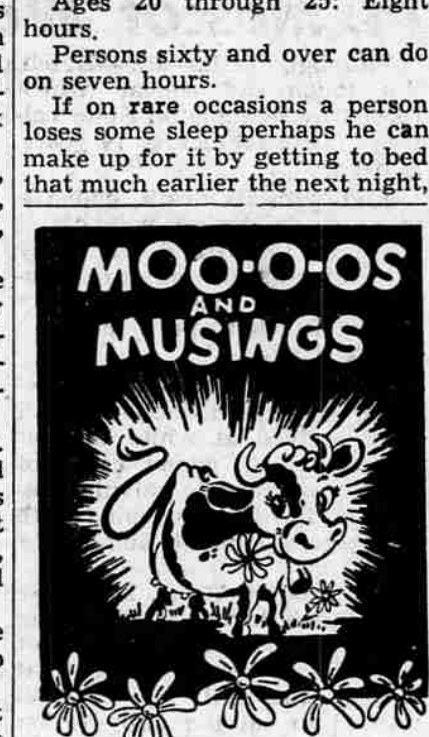
Two other passengers were injured and are reported in fair condition at Salem General hospital. They are Wayne Jennings, 21, and Morris E. Drummond, 19, both of Albany.

Deputy Coroner Charles C. Edward of Marion county said the car in which the five youths were riding apparently went out of control on the frosty road, turned on its side and skidded into a tree.

The top of the car had to be opened by a wrecker crew to remove the victims.

Coroner L. W. Howell has not yet decided whether an inquest will be held into the crash.
