Mixing of Politics With Business Out

Chicago — (AP) — Nearly all state and local public employees are forbidden in some degree to mix politics with the public's business, according to the Civil Service Assembly.
The assembly cited a study made by Richard Christopherson of Philadelphia's personnel department. Christopherson surveyed 119 civil service jurisdictions at the state and local level.
Of the 119, only five had no control over the political activities of their public servants. The great majority, 89 per cent, exercised at least some measure of restraint.

(Q) "My son, who entered junior high this fall, spends much too much time on his studies. I have watched him when he is supposed to be doing his lessons, and I notice that he spends more time looking elsewhere than looking at his book. He will leave his desk, look out the window, turn on his radio, pick up a magazine or comic and look at it, stand in front of the mirror and straighten his hair, and do a number of other such things. Naturally he gets little done, and his grades show it. I would like him to go to college, but I can't see how he will ever make college unless he learns to concentrate better."
