ALTERNATIVE FOR RISKY SURGERY

Some years ago when I was using every means God and Hippocrates would sanction to persuade the profession to accept electrocoagulation (diathermy) as the method of choice for the treatment of infected tonsils—never mind now whether this effort was successful or not—I heard from a credulous customer in Indiana who wanted advice about I forget just what I believe I printed the essential details here but I can't take time out from my bowling to find the article now.

The Indian had gone through the clinic—the best advertised clinic, that is—and when he finally came up to the big noise he learned that his trouble was undoubtedly a focal infection and the only effective treatment would be removal of his infected tonsils, but that was out of the question because of the condition of his heart, so he had better go home, walk on eggs for the rest of his life and waste no money on doctors or treatment.

At least that was the Hoosier's version of what they told him. I suggested that the septic focus might be sterilized, pasteurized, disinfected, or drained by diathermy treatment (electrocoagulation) which is perfectly safe for any one. The correspondent found a doctor skilled in electrocoagulation, had the series of treatments, improved steadily in health and presently forgot all the sorry prognostications.
