

Around Hollywood

Hollywood—(U.P.)—A tall, dark and handsome man reversed the usual Hollywood story today: He actually is "embarrassed" because the folks back home think he's romancing Yvonne de Carlo.

Most busy bachelors eagerly boast they date the globe-trotting glamour girl. But Salah Sayed Ahmed, a 29-year-old Egyptian police officer, sighed nervously his casual dates with Yvonne got him in dutch in Cairo.

"There are all these stories about a romance. They are not true!" he said fervently. "Yvonne is a wonderful girl, a very nice girl, and I see her, but just as a friend."

Came to Study
"I came here to study motion picture production at the University of Southern California, and to work with Director C. B. DeMille. Every year my government must renew my study permit and if these stories continue, they may make me come home."

Salah met the sultry movie queen in Cairo last summer when he was one of the technical advisors to DeMille during filming of "The Ten Commandments." Yvonne is not in the film, but happened to drop in on one of her many round-the-world jaunts. She had nothing to do with his move to Hollywood, he insisted.

"I had been corresponding with the university for 13 months, long before I met Yvonne," he said. "I do not know how many years I will study here. Depends on the trouble with my government in Egypt."

His plan, he said unhappily, got shaky when he arrived here a month ago and the gossip columnists buzzed about his dates with Yvonne.

"She is not my only friend," he said. "I've met hundreds of Americans. I know everybody at Warners, Paramount and MGM. "Why, there are 100 girls more beautiful than Yvonne in Hollywood," exclaimed the Egyptian.

Miss de Carlo, on movie location in the Bahamas, was not available to comment on that.
