DON'T MAKE A FEDERAL CASE OF IT

From the continuing high mortality which tonsillectomy maintains in Yankeeland—a statistical tabulation of the fatalities from this atrocity, mostly young children, if one had the time or the inclination to record them, would appall sentient parents, might even cause some to put off the proposed tonsillectomy till next summer or autumn—when, likely as not, "those bad tonsils" the everready operators insist "must come out without delay" will have shrunk to normal anyway.

That is, if the kids are permitted to play outdoors as much as they wish, rain, hail, warm, cold, damp, snow, blow, cloud or sunshine.

Ay, there's the rub. Few parents know enough (about hygiene) to give their children free reign about this. Either they regard their children as idiots incapable of knowing whether they are comfortable or they go along with the medical authorities—holders from the nineteenth century—who still imagine simple everyday "exposure" to cold, dampness, draft, change, etc., accounts for whatever illnesses they are unable to diagnose accurately.

Every day I thank God for blessings bestowed on those I love and ask for the wisdom and patience I need to make doctors and folks understand the difference between tonsillectomy and tonsillotomy.

Tonsillectomy means an attempt to remove every bit of tonsil tissue from the throat. I say the attempt because nine

times out of 10 more or less tonsil tissue remains after the operation.

Tonsillotomy means snipping off the obstructing portion of tonsil, instantaneously.

Upon non-recognition, unawareness, ignorance of the histology and pathology of the tonsils the businessmen of medicine have developed their peculiar belief that it is tonsil, and (no) tissue in itself that injures health.

If tonsil tissue were malignant extensive dissection of the throat in the attempt to eradicate it, as in tonsillectomy, would be rational treatment. Perhaps the most convincing evidence that it is not malignant or harmful in any way is the everyday observation of odds and ends of tonsil which remain intact long after tonsillectomy.
