# CORRECT YOUR DIET AND FEEL BETTER

From down east a lady writes:

Dear Dr. Brady:

The O.I. is unworthy. . . . Everybody envies my being so full of pep. I tell them it is thanks to Dr. Brady, but they smile at my naivety and continue to drag around, even after "shots" . . . most of them younger in years but none seems to have vite.

Well, Ma'am, that isn't our fault, is it? You tried to tell 'em, and for years I have been telling 'em. But the poor geeks like to dream they can get it in "shots" at \$7.50 per without bothering their heads about diet, nutrition, temperance, natural breathing, exercise, care of the teeth or other silly notions—after all, they can always dispel their inferiority complexes with another cocktail or highball.

Whether the racketeer soaks the customer \$7.50 or \$3 per "shot," there's no good reason for administering vitamins that way, if the customer can still take nourishment by mouth.

In rare instances of advanced malnutrition it is necessary to inject into a vein many times more than the normal daily requirement of one or more vitamins.

One reader informs me that vitamins are magic, for whenever he gets utterly tired out and exhausted he drops in at the "clinic" and gets a "shot," and presently he is on his toes again and in fine spirits. Do I know anything else that will do that?

I do not. But I believe a shot of sterile tap water would have the same effect.

# Belton Said Source Of Controversial Bill

Salem — (U.P.)—The origin of a controversial bill regarding control of betterment funds of state departments was clarified at a Ways and Means Committee hearing when Sen. Howard Belton (R-Canby), co-chairman of the committee, identified himself as the source of the bill.

Harry Dorman, state director of finance, yesterday was the target of criticism from the Board of Control which accused him of drafting the bill without clearing it with the board, even though it affected Board control of the betterment funds.

Dorman yesterday told the board that the request to draft the bill had come from the Ways and Means Committee but he did not identify Belton as the individual source.
