MAN WANTS BUT LITTLE IODINE

As a matter of fact straight cod liver oil, two ounces (about 4 tablespoonfuls) a day was formerly one of the best remedies for the rheumatiz, and in my opinion still is. Pure cod liver oil is a rich source of vitamin A, vitamin D and iodine.

Make up your mind about it, Ma'am. Have you joint inflammation (arthritis) or joint degeneration (rheumatiz)? If it is arthritis the only suggestion I can offer is that you follow your doctor's advice and pay no attention to what any blithering quack says in the papers. If you can't make up your mind what ails you, send me a stamped, self-addressed envelope for the pamphlet Let Calcium and Rheumatiz. If you're curious about the meaning of degeneration look up the medical definition of the word in Webster's.

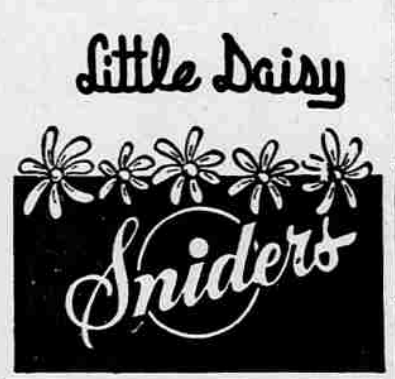

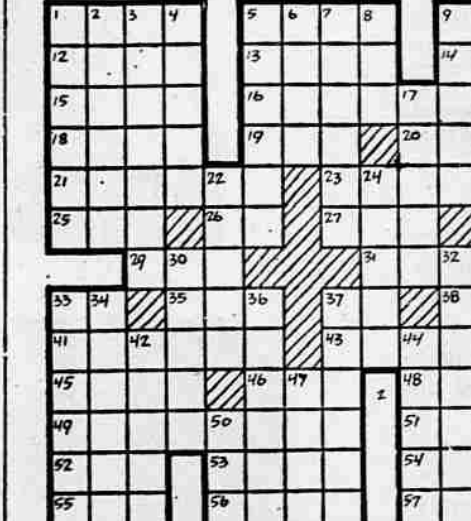

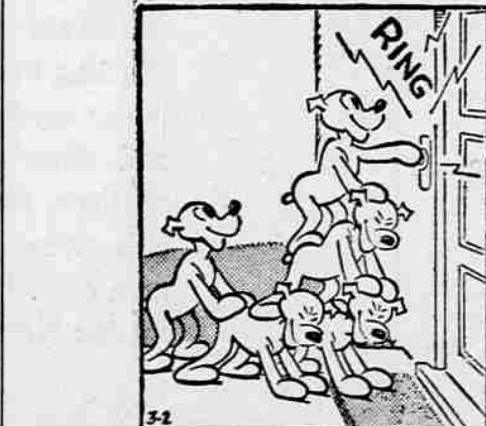
