Notice is given hereby that John W. Horner has filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Applegate River.

Certificate of Water Right issued to Fred R. Benedict and recorded at page 2685, Vol. 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confers a right under Permit No. 4209 for the irrigation of 15 acres in NE¹/₄, NW¹/₄, and 15 acres in NW¹/₄, NW¹/₄, Sec. 22, T. 38 S., R. 4 W., W.M., from Applegate River with a date of priority of Aug. 6, 1919. These lands are irrigated thru the Fowler-Keeler or Kubli ditch, the point of diversion of said ditch being located 2000 ft. S. and 750 ft. E. from SW¹/₄ cor. of Sec. 29, and being within SW¹/₄, NE¹/₄, said Sec. 29, T. 38 S., R. 3 W., W.M.

John W. Horner, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate said lands by means of a pumping plant, the point of diversion of said plant to be located 1235 ft. S. and 1620 ft. E. from NW cor. of Sec. 22, and being within NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, said Sec. 22, T. 38 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

All persons interested are notified hereby that a hearing will be held at the county court house at Medford, Ore., on May 12, 1955, beginning at 10:00 A.M. All objections to the proposed change, if any there are, will be heard at said time and place. Any objections shall be prepared in writing, one copy to be served on John W. Horner, Star Rt. 1, Box 82, Jacksonville, Ore., and one copy to be mailed to the State Engineer, Salem, Ore., together with a \$2 filing fee, at least 10 days prior to the date set for hearing. If no objections are filed, the application may be approved by the State Engineer without a hearing.
