Future Autos May Have Quiet Engines

Chicago — (U.P.) — Some day you may drive an automobile with an engine so quiet you won't know it's running.

Such things as under-hood acoustical blankets and firewall treatment can render engines virtually noiseless, David C. Apps, a General Motors official, told a National Noise Abatement Symposium.

Apps said a new vehicle noise standard prohibits trucks to exceed more than 125 sones (units of loudness) at 50 feet. This he said, has caused manufacturers to develop better mufflers and "should provide a powerful inducement" for improvement of

PAINFUL TYPOGRAPHICAL ERROR

In the third paragraph of the piece about breast pang released for publication here Tuesday, Feb. 15, I said:

"Nitroglycerin (glyceryl trinitrate, glonoin) or sodium nitrate or other vasodilator prescribed for anginal distress is practically harmless."

I tried to explain parenthetically what vasodilator means, and when the piece was printed it came out like this: "casodilator (dilator or relator of blood vessels)."

This might puzzle or confuse any one. I was puzzled when I saw what a botch we had made of it. What I tried to say is that vasodilator means dilator or relaxer of blood vessels, particularly the smallest terminal branches of the arteries, properly called arterioles, not capillaries.

Contraction, constriction, spasm of the muscle coat in the wall of the arteriole narrows the calibre of the little vessel, which is scarcely visible to the naked eye. Such narrowing restricts delivery of blood (oxygen) to the bit of functioning tissue or the group cells in the heart muscle fed by the arteriole. Hence the distress of angina pectoris or coronary occlusion or thrombosis.

This typographical error hurt me more than it did you poor souls, I hope. But there is some consolation in the belief that correction of the error may bring to more readers knowledge of the tremendous relief available to countless subjects of heart and artery trouble who

will learn how to make regular use of nitroglycerin.

In No. 2 Little Lesson, the booklet C.V.D. for which send 25c and stamped, self-addressed envelope, I tell all you need to know about the everyday use of nitroglycerin, except how to get it without (1) persuading a doctor to write a prescription for it and (2) paying a fee for the prescription.

Unfortunately there is a regulation in some communities prohibiting sale of nitroglycerin tablets without prescription. But from what numerous readers have told me I infer that they have a relative or friend who

works in a drugstore or maybe a standing order given by a doctor, so they can get a hundred tablets whenever they need 'em.

Nitroglycerin is almost instantly absorbed, whether given hypodermically or by mouth. Within seconds after a nitroglycerin tablet is put in the mouth, under the tongue, the face and neck become flushed, the heart pounds and you feel throbbing and fullness in the head—and if you do not know about these common effects you may be frightened, dizzy and faint. In any case the effects are soon over—in from ten minutes to half an hour—and the novice will be less distressed if he takes the test dose lying down and remains so for at least ten minutes.

If no immediate effects occur, in five or ten minutes try doubling the test dose. If still no

effects, in another five minutes quadruple the test dose. If still no effects, the tablets are inert—the nitroglycerin has volatilized. Get fresh tablets which have not been exposed to the air, and put one to the test to make sure your emergency medicine is not just make-believe.

Doctors and Dentists Are People From time to time the conductor of this column offers to send data, or perhaps a reference to a subject discussed in the column, to physicians or dentists who ask for it and provide a stamped, addressed envelope. About one out of four physicians or dentists who ask for such service omit the stamped, addressed envelope. Sorry, I'd like to serve them, but at their own expense.

Cooking What method of cooking will retain the most vitamins and other nutrients in foods? (P. G.)

Answer—Vitamin B complex and vitamin C are destroyed by prolonged heating to a high degree. The other

vitamins are not much affected by cooking. So the less cooking the better. Cooking has little effect on minerals in food. Some vitamins, some minerals, are dissolved out of food in boiling—so the cooking water should be used for gravy, soup, etc., not thrown away.

Infection I am a truck driver and I suppose I breathe more or less carbon monoxide all day. Would that, or inhaling fumes of a paint spray gun poison my blood stream enough to cause a bad infection on the back of my neck? (B. R. K.)

Answer—There is probably no connection between carbon monoxide or the paint solvents and skin infection. Occasional bellyache diagnosed by

physician as mild appendicitis. Only treatment he advised is removal of appendix if I have acute appendicitis, and no seeds in diet... (R. T.)

Answer—Either you have appendicitis or you haven't. There is no ground for the notion that seeds have anything to do with appendicitis. (Protected 1955 by John F. Dille Co.)

Aluminum Plants To Use Steam Power

Portland — (U.P.) — Major aluminum plants in the Northwest whose production was threatened by a 35 per cent cutback in their interruptible power supply plan to buy more expensive steam generated power to keep operating at present capacity, a Bonneville Power Administration spokesman said today.

Aluminum plants were the biggest users of power among the 14 Northwest industries affected by the cutback order, which is effective Monday. Others probably will follow suit in using steam power, the BPA spokesman said.

Bonneville officials said the cost of using steam-generated power to replace the 35 per cent cut would be about \$15,000 a day more than the plants were paying for the interruptible power.

The cutback was ordered because of cold weather and low stream flow.

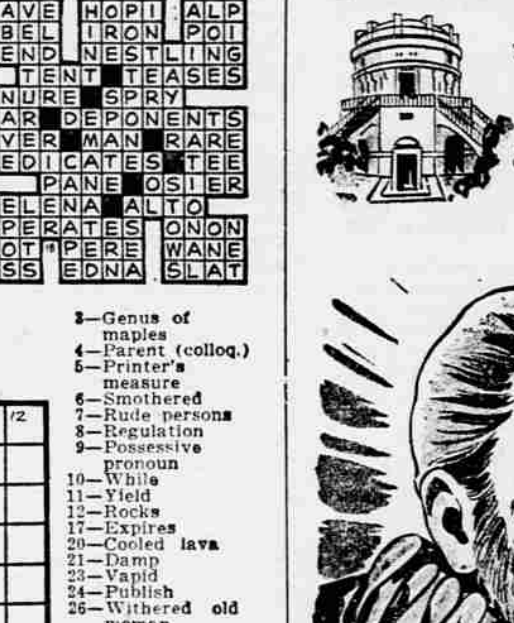
