Apartment Fire Chases Tenants

Portland—(U.P.)—Tenants from 26 apartments fled into the street here early yesterday as fire destroyed one apartment in the building and seriously damaged two others.

Firemen said the \$2300 blaze apparently started in a faulty radio in the apartment of Edward Armstrong. The building is located at 1130 NE 1st ave.
