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It can be said on good authority that some of the responsible Democratic leaders in Congress believe that, as of now, Mr. Eisenhower looks almost unbeatable in 1956 if he seeks a second term. Time will tell whether the situation changes in the next 19 months.

In contrast to this bearishness about their presidential chances, the Democrats are confident they can retain control of Congress, at least the Senate.

Unlike many Republicans and neutral observers, a number of Democrats are by no means convinced that Mr. Eisenhower will take a second nomination.

The Democratic strategy in Congress almost seems to rest on that assumption. A more important reason for kid-glove treatment of Mr. Eisenhower, however, is the belief that any other policy now would backfire by creating public resentment.

But to a questioner who asked when the firing at Mr. Eisenhower can be expected, one Democratic leader replied:

"The Republicans didn't try to subpoena Harry Truman; they settled for Harry Vaughan."

This was a reference to Maj. Gen. Harry H. Vaughan, President Truman's friend and military aide and a frequent target for Republican political barages.

Walk Softly For reasons like these, the Democrats prefer to ignore or tip their hats to M. Eisenhower and to throw their punches at Secretary of Agriculture Ezra T. Benson, Secretary of Treasury George M. Humphrey and others.

Some real resentment is building now against Secretary of State John Foster Dulles for publishing the Yalta documents last week only two days after the State Department said matters of security and relations with other countries forbade their release.

To some Democrats, Dulles' action was a severe blow at bipartisanship in foreign policy. With Democrats now controlling Congress, they felt that he had slapped the party on which he must rely for congressional support of administration policy.
