MAKE YOUR PEAK A MESA

Maybe I'm feeling a little cocky today, about health and longevity. I mean, because for the past three weeks, I tell you frankly, I have been worried.

You see, some three weeks ago I caught intercostal neuralgia or maybe radical it's—

darting pains here and there in the trunk with tenderness and sharp pain on movement. While the thing lasted I found I couldn't do my morning rolls—in fact I was afraid to try, and that made me feel pretty decrepit. But everything's jake again. I'm back on regular schedule, feeling just a little sorrier for the poor souls so decrepit that they dare not try to somersault . . . do forward rolls on floor or ground. On written request accompanied with stamped, self-addressed envelope I'll send a pamphlet The Somersaulting which tells how and why every adult who is not crippled should do half a dozen rolls first thing every morning.

Another reason for my cockiness, I believe, is that all my teeth (some of which were installed by my dentist) seem to be in perfect functional condition—all working full time to maintain good digestion, good nutrition, good health, (I was going to say good looks but instead I'll say) the best possible personal appearance, vite and longevity.

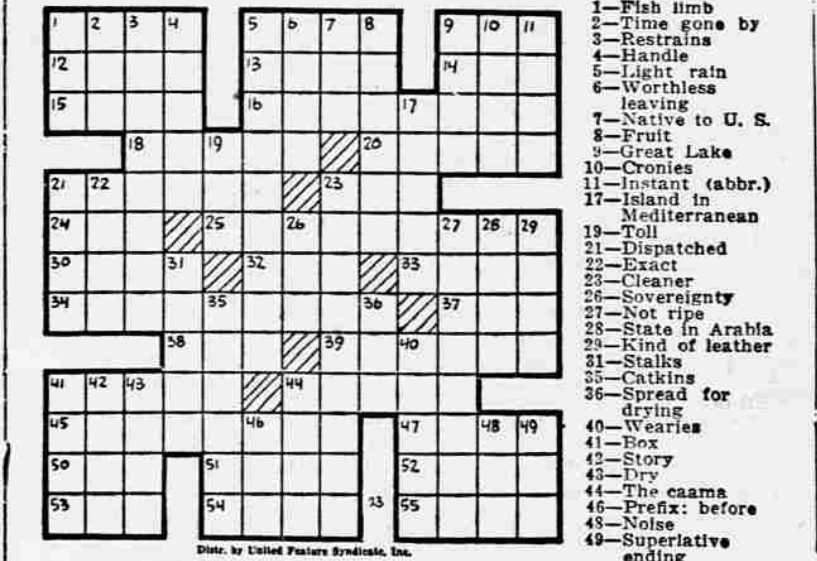
