Your Health and Its Care

ARTHRITIS OF THE JOINTS

Remember the fellow who slips in between the Lone Ranger and Groucho, puts on a barber coat, spectacles and stethoscope and tells the lady how the medicine wakes up her liver bile? In my suspicious way I thought he was a phony, but the other day I heard from his cousin, who has arthritis of the joints and that reminded me of a neighbor of ours on Chapel Street in Canandaigua who used to come down with pneumonia on the lungs.

Everyone knows I'm no authority, but just a plodding practitioner turned quack in order to make a decent living. A quack, says Webster, is one who professes skill or knowledge in any matter of which he knows little or nothing. Modestly I profess only as much knowledge of the subject to joint disability as is available to the medical profession, having had more time to study the subject than most real doctors have.

There was a bowling alley right around the corner from my medical school, and it is possible that I cut class the day Prof. Pohlman lectured on the biliary tract. I remember only one variety of bile, but then there's a vague notion that all gall is divided into three parts. So I had better not be too positive about arthritis which doesn't affect the joints. To my mind arthritis means joint inflammation and nothing else.

Recognized medical authorities, from Osler down to the present time, have described various types or kinds of joint disability under such names as rheumatoid arthritis, arthritis deformans, atrophic arthritis, hypertrophic arthritis, osteoarthritis, degenerative arthritis, and several more, but it has proved impossible to determine whether these authors are talking about the same thing. When one has studied them all, one with a one-track mind cannot help wondering how they get away with it.

A bulletin issued by the Arthritis and Rheumatism Foundation, 23 W. 45th St., New York 36, N.Y., last May said:

"It should now be recognized that treatment with the

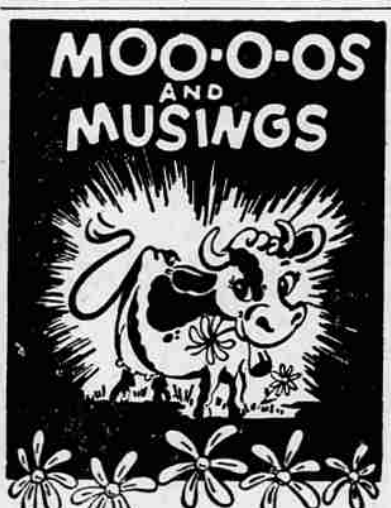
various drugs available today has not been shown to alter the natural course of the disease in a significant manner. The bulletin pointed out that the dramatic and immediate effects of the wonder drugs introduced in recent years disappear when the drugs are discontinued.

The bulletin was not so pessimistic as the part quoted might indicate, or it said that of 282 patients undergoing conservative treatment—rest, supervised exercise, casts, splints, aspirin for pain, adequate diet supplemented with essential vitamins and minerals—200 were substantially improved and 113 were restored to self-sufficiency and active social and economic life.
