THE PARTINGTONS AND THE MALAPROPS

Can a doctor determine by examination that a person is allergic, or is it just a figure of speech to say "I'm allergic to" anything I dislike? It seems to me you have discussed this in your column but the recollection is hazy . . . (L. H.)

Allergy, a state of hypersensitivity (oversensitivity) to one substance or another taken into the body in food or medicine, by inhalation or by absorption through scratches, punctures, burns, blisters, cuts, ulcers or other break in the skin.

This peculiar sensitivity of some persons to substances which do not affect normal individuals at all, such as horse dander, canary feathers or orris root, seems to be more prevalent now but this may be because doctors too readily recognize the manifestations

of allergy which doctors of twenty years ago didn't understand.

By skin tests—minute quantities of this or that applied to tiny scratches on the skin—a doctor can determine whether a person is allergic and usually to what.

From the medical literature on the subject, into which I have dipped considerably in the past ten years, I have become enamored of a pet notion (remember, folks, I am the first to call it a pet notion) that calcium deficiency is an underlying factor if not

Reject Back Pay For Deckhands

Portland —(U.P.)— The State Highway Commission has turned down a request of the Astoria Navigation Company for reimbursement of back pay for three deckhands of the Astoria-Megler ferries.

The Coast Guard ordered two more pilots added to the ferries and eliminated the requirement for three deckhands. The navigation company let the deckhands go but later had to rehire them after losing a court suit.

The commission in other actions:

Set May 24 as date for a hearing in Sheridan on the proposed Sheridan by-pass.

Postponed action on approval of supplementary traffic controls with two luminaires at a cost of \$700 at the Stanfield junction near La Grande until Commissioner Charles H. Reynolds, La Grande, investigates. Engineer R. H. Baldock recommended approval.

Accepted deed from Clatsop county for 761 acres of Fort Stevens for a proposed park area. Also accepted 3.77 acres from Coos county for part of Bandon state park. The counties retain oil and mineral rights.

Czechoslovakian Youths Flee To West Germany

Regensburg, Germany —(U.P.) Two Czech anti-Communists hedge-hopped a tiny airplane 175 miles through Red jet patrols to freedom in West Germany yesterday.

The Czechs, about 25 years of age, landed the stolen single-engine sports craft in a field 30 miles south of here and immediately asked German police for political asylum.

American Army authorities from a base at Landshtut took the men for questioning. The Army declined to make an immediate statement, however.

Now, wait a minute. Calcium in Egg Shell

Approximately how much powdered egg shell would supply the minimum

daily requirement of calcium? (E. A. H.)
