MODERN TREATMENT OF PILES

Practically painless injection (ambulatory, office) treatment for internal hemorrhoids (piles), which detains the patient only a few minutes, once or twice a week, for from four to eight times, is far more satisfactory than the crude 19th century clamp and cautery operation, which hospitalizes the victim for one to two weeks and is generally attended with or followed by a good deal of pain.

This is the consensus of the many correspondents who have reported their experience. I hope no reader will assume that injection treatment is the best modern treatment for any case of hemorrhoids (piles). In my judgement it is the method of choice for internal (bleeding) piles—at least it would be if I were the patient. But injection treatment is not applicable to external (the most painful) piles.

External piles demand surgery—the surgery may be done in the doctor's office, perhaps under local anesthesia. But there is no alternative, to the best of my knowledge.

A great deal of popular misunderstanding of the question of treatment of piles is due to the fact that a so-called "attack" of piles—that is, accession of or development of great pain and discomfort—naturally subsides in the course of a week, more or less, no matter whether any remedy or treatment has been used or not.

It is difficult to give in a newspaper detailed instructions in hygiene, prevention, alleviation of the "attack," etc., but on request I'll send a pamphlet on Piles, if you pay the freight, that is, provide stamped envelope bearing your address.

Many old timers still in practice will growl or sneer at you if or when you venture to ask about this ambulatory or injection treatment you have heard about and if they tell you the method was tried long ago and discarded as "no good" or too dangerous or doesn't cure, that is all true. The same objections apply to radical surgery, except that, as I have tried to explain, the mod-

ern injection method is worth trying first, unless you are a stoic.

Doctor Says Incurably Ill Should Be Informed
Portland — (U.P.)—Nearly all persons ill of cancer or any other deadly disease want to be told of such an illness, according to Dr. Bernard P. Harpole, clinical instructor in surgery at the University of Oregon medical school.

Dr. Harpole, in an article in the April issue of Current Medical Digest, said 97 per cent of persons incurably ill wanted to be so informed.

In cases where death was imminent, the doctor said, 85 per cent wanted to know as soon as possible, and nine per cent wanted to know the predicated date of death.

Dr. Harpole said his statistics were based on a form filled out by 141 patients.

House Passes Bill for Committeeman Election

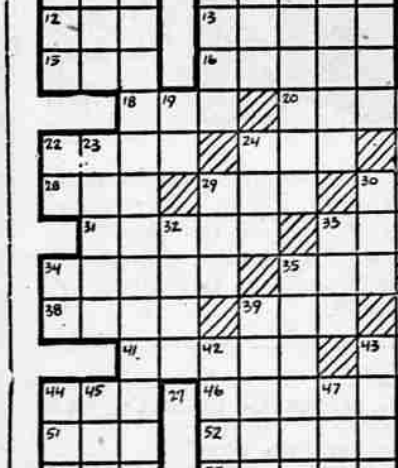
There will be a small admission charge.

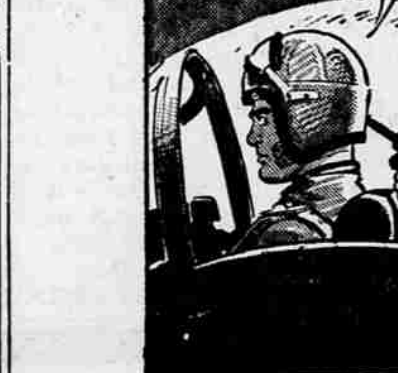

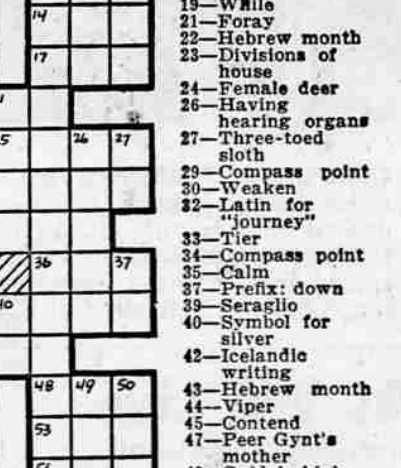

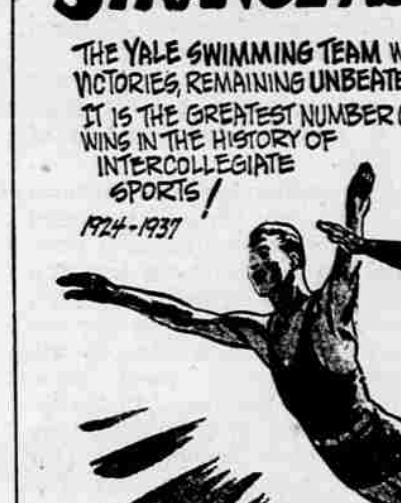
