Opened Missions
During their first term on the field the Parks opened two mission stations in the province of Kwang Sai. In their second term they worked in Hong Kong until they were interned in Stanley camp during the Japanese war. After six months of imprisonment they were repatriated.

In 1945 the Rev. Mr. Park was one of the first missionaries who returned to China after the Japanese war. Mrs. Park went to China the following year and together they remained on the field until last year. Mrs. Park has had wide experience in children's and young people's work.

They have up-to-date information regarding the Communist situation and the general outlook for the strategic colony of Hong Kong. They will have a display of curios and show colored slides depicting phases of Chinese life and gospel work in South China. The public is invited.
