### ONE GOOD TURN DESERVES ANOTHER

She is 48 years old and her friends say she looks ten years younger—from the snapshot of the young woman and her husband, taken last year, I'd say Whee-ehheeh—if her husband were not so big. But age is not important, the young woman continues, what counts is how she feels.

### Two More Retired Generals Appointed

Washington — (U.P.) — The House Armed Services committee has approved two more retired generals for top jobs in the Immigration Service despite protests that President Eisenhower was loading the government with military men.

Gen. J. M. Swing, immigration and naturalization commissioner, told the committee that he would be "hamstrung" if he did not get Maj. Gen. Frank H. Partridge and Brig. Gen. Edwin B. Howard as \$11,800 a year assistant commissioners.

Swing said he had searched the Immigration Service but had been unable to find anyone for the top level posts.

He said Partridge would head the service's enforcement division and take over border patrol problems. Howard, Swing said, would take over the service's inspection and Security Division and coordinate its activities with the Central Intelligence Agency and the FBI.

### Medical Technologists Will Attend Meeting

Several southern Oregon medical technologists will be attending a state meeting and seminar being conducted Saturday in Portland by the Association of Oregon Medical Technologists, they reported this week.

The eighth annual spring seminar and state meeting will be held at the Medical Dental Building auditorium. Featured speakers will include Dr. Arthur W. Frisch, associate professor of bacteriology at the University of Oregon Medical School. He will discuss "Recent Advances in Blood Groups."

Registration for the scientific session will open at 8:30 a.m. The meeting and seminar is open to all those in the clinical laboratory field, public health laboratories, research laboratories, teachers in the field of science, and other interested persons.
