California Resumes Polio Inoculations

Berkeley, Calif.—(U.P.)—California health officers prepared today to resume anti-polio inoculations with vaccine okayed by the U.S. Department of Public Health.

Dr. Malcolm Merrill, California director of public health, said the state now has enough vaccine on hand to complete the state wide inoculation of an estimated 533,000 first and second grade children.

He said the program in Southern California has been almost completed with the previously approved Parke Davis vaccine. However, in Los Angeles, city and county health departments were to give 27,500 first and second grade pupils their first injections today.

In northern California, clearance of all Eli Lilly vaccine yesterday signaled the go-ahead for nearly all counties from San Francisco north.

Dutch Ambassador Says People Ready To Fight for Peace

Holland, Mich.—(U.P.)—Dr. J. H. Van Roijen, The Netherlands ambassador to the United States, said Friday his people were willing to fight for a peace "built on justice, honor and decency."

Van Roijen, who came here with his wife from Washington to visit Holland's annual tulip festival, said the Dutch have gained increasing self-confidence, self-reliance and self-assurance since the end of World War II.

He attributed his people's resurgence to the establishment of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, a rebirth of economic strength and the presence of American troops in Europe. Coincidence with U. S.

The Netherlands diplomat told a predominantly Dutch-American audience that his country's views on Russia more closely coincide with American views on the Soviets than with those of any other nation.

Formerly Netherlands ambassador to India, Van Roijen praised India's Prime Minister Nehru as a "great stabilizing force in Asia" and a "fighter of Communism."

He said Nehru has been accused of appeasing the Chinese Reds, but advised his audience "when you know more about the Indian's reasoning, then what Nehru is doing makes sense."

Auto-Bus Crash Kills One, Hurts 11
Oxnard, Calif.—(U.P.)—One man was killed and 11 other persons injured last night when a Los Angeles bound Greyhound bus rammed broadside into a passenger car five miles east of here.

California highway patrolmen said the dead man was Jess V. Meraz, 43, of Santa Paula, Calif., the driver of the car. Officers said Meraz apparently failed to stop at an intersection.

The bus, carrying 33 passengers, careened 200 feet across a ditch and landed on a railroad track. The bus driver, Chester Green, of South Gate, Calif., was among six of the injured who were in serious condition, the patrol said.

Carpenters To Vote On Latest Offers
Portland—(U.P.)—Portland district of the council of carpenters announced Saturday that its affiliated locals with a membership of 8000 will meet May 31 to vote on any new offers contractors might make.

If no new offers are made by Portland's three large contractor groups, locals will vote on to go on strike June 1. A strike would be directed only against those firms which have not granted the district council's demands for a 10-cent hourly wage increase and additional travel pay.

The state council recently negotiated a 5 1/2-cent hourly wage increase, but the Portland group seeks higher benefits for its members.
