LITTLE LESSON IN PATHOLOGY

The branch of medical science which treats of the nature and cause of disease and the structural and functional changes that characterize disease is pathology.

The expert who does the autopsy (necropsy) for the coroner is a pathologist, although commonly called medical examiner. Far more important is the service of the pathologist in surgical diagnosis. In a great many instances the physician's opinion of the nature of the trouble is confirmed or negated by the pathologist's examination of material the doctor submits, and perhaps a vital decision for or against radical treatment becomes possible.

The most valuable service of the pathologist is in the performance of the biopsy. Standing by, with microscope and other equipment ready, the pathologist quickly examines a bit

of tissue obtained by the surgeon, and reports what his examination reveals. This enables the surgeon to conserve tissue which otherwise he might have removed, or otherwise he might have assumed the condition to be benign.

In these days of "wonder drugs" or "miracle medicines" some doctors who use these drugs as cure-alls seem unconscious of elementary pathology. Otherwise it's hard to see how they can expect the latest miracle medicine to cure anything.

When a physician calls your chronic (a year or more in duration) joint disability "arthritis" and prescribes medicine, diet, physical therapy, change of climate, etc., well, it's just too bad—and that's as far as I purpose to go today. Founder of Negro College for Women Passes in Florida

Dayton Beach, Fla. — (U.P.) — Dr. Mary McLeod Bethune, who founded a college on a dump heap with \$1.50 and became the most prominent Negro woman of her time, died here Wednesday night of a heart attack.

Dr. Bethune would have been 80 years old July 10. She had been ill for some time, physicians said, but her mind remained active.

She collapsed late Wednesday after spending a full day writing at her desk, friends said.

Hearing the news, some 400 students of the Bethune-Cookman college for Negroes, which she founded, filed out of a prayer meeting singing hymns to pay her homage.

Born on a plantation in Mayesville, S.C., one of 17 children. Friends helped her gain an education but she often worked at menial tasks to complete it.

President Franklin D. Roosevelt appointed Dr. Bethune as director of Negro affairs for the National Youth Administration and as his special adviser on minority affairs.

She founded the National Council for Negro Women 20 years ago. She was listed in Who's Who. She held honorary degrees from 14 colleges and universities and was honored by several foreign governments.

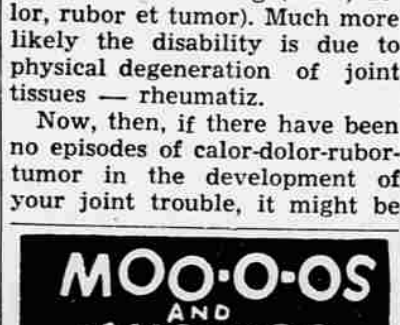
Hillbilly Jamboree Plans Now Under Way
