Ferbam Spray Ups Yield of Apples

Geneva, N. Y. (U.P.)—A five-year experiment to control scab with a ferbam spray program resulted in increased yields of U.S. No. 1 apples in a Hudson Valley orchard.

The program included eight different treatments with lead arsenate as the basic insecticide. All were equally effective in controlling scab, according to a report just released by the New York state agricultural experiment station here.

An all-season program of ferbam fungicides proved safest and resulted in the highest yields and best fruit quality. Cost per box also was the highest with this program, but the increased production of U.S. No. 1 apples justified the added expense.
