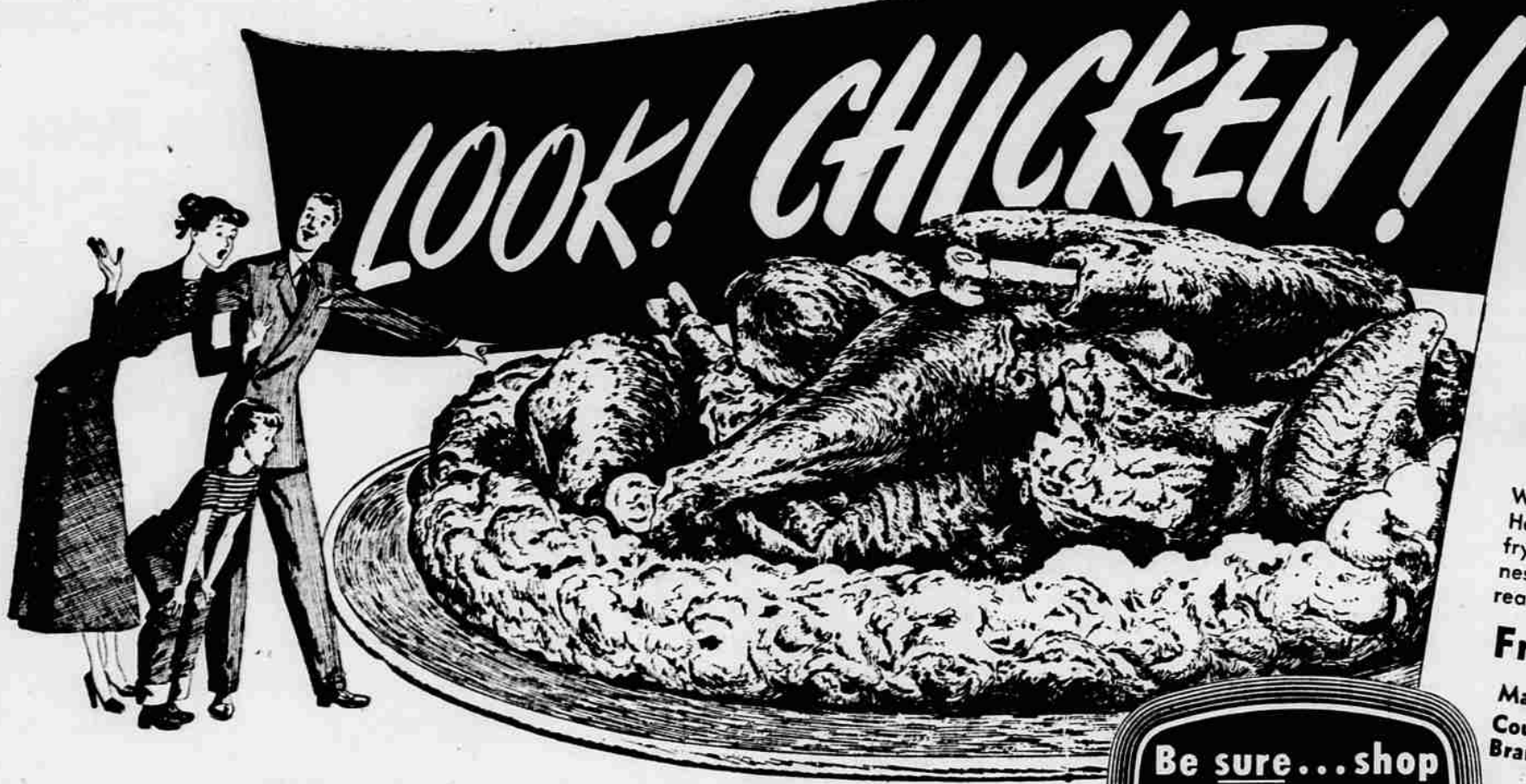

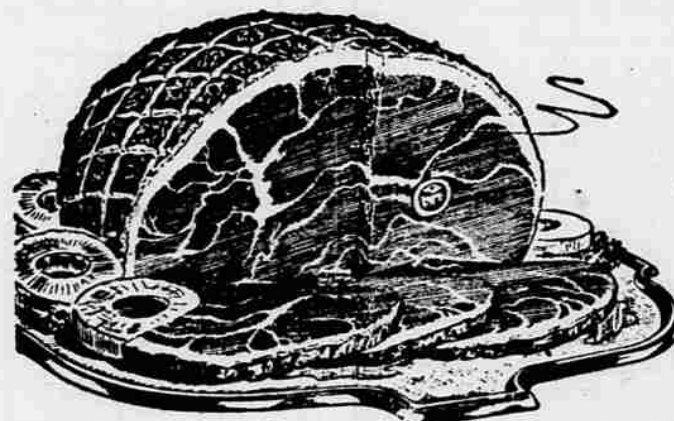

Convicted Reds Tell of Plan To Appeal Verdict

Denver —(U.P.)— Seven lower echelon Communists convicted Wednesday night of conspiring to advocate the violent overthrow of the United States government served notice today they would appeal their convictions while they remained free on bond.

District Judge Jean S. Breitenstein gave 11 court-appointed attorneys for the defense until June 9 to file motions and set June 15 as the day the motions would be argued.

Appeal Notice Given

Arthur Bary, 43, one of the defendants who was described by the FBI as a Communist underground leader assigned to find out how FBI agents were tracking down Reds, said minutes after the jury returned its verdict "we intend to appeal."

The verdict was returned by the jury of seven men and five women after eight hours and 20 minutes of deliberation. The jurors had listened to a large number of government witnesses and extended arguments since the trial started March 23.

Face Five Years

The defendants, including Bary's 29-year-old wife, Anna, face a maximum of five years in prison and \$10,000 fines if their appeals fail.

The five other defendants were Harold Zepelin, Lewis Johnson of Utah, Joseph William Scherrer and Mal Scherrer, his wife of Pueblo, Colo., and Patricia Blau of Los Angeles.

The government had stated in its Smith Act indictments the seven plotted the destruction of the government by force at meetings in Colorado over a period of years.

Bryson Attorneys Request New Trial

San Francisco —(U.P.)— Attorneys for former left wing maritime labor leader Hugh Bryson, who have asked for a new trial for the convicted perjurer, said today they were confident he "would not serve a day in jail."

Bryson, 40-year-old former leader of the now-defunct National Union of Marine Cooks & Stewards, was convicted by a federal court jury yesterday for falsely swearing in a Taft-Hartley affidavit that he was not "affiliated with" the Communist party.

The jury of seven women and five men found Bryson innocent of a second count charging that he lied when he swore he was not an actual member of the party.

The jury reached the verdict in the court of Federal Judge William C. Mathes after 10 hours of deliberation which started early Tuesday afternoon. The judge will hear arguments for a new trial on June 8.

Phoenix Firemen Plan To Offer Inspections

Phoenix — The Phoenix volunteer fire department will conduct a home fire prevention program beginning June 1, Leo Furry, fire chief has announced.

The firemen will make a house-to-house canvass to point out to householders common fire hazards which exist in most homes, and how fire can be prevented by removing them. The firemen will not be looking for violations and will be there merely to be helpful to homeowners or occupants.

Three Mining Claims Recorded in County

Three mining claims were filed in the Jackson county recorder's office Tuesday.

William A. Reese Sr., and Dr. R. L. Falk filed a claim for cinabar and other valuable minerals in the Evans Meadows mining district. The claims are known as Kathleen No. 1 and Kathleen No. 2. Reese gave his address as Canyonville, Ore.

A claim for gold and other minerals in the Sterling Mining district was filed by George A. Holt, 107 Walden lane, Talent. The claim is known as No Fooling.
