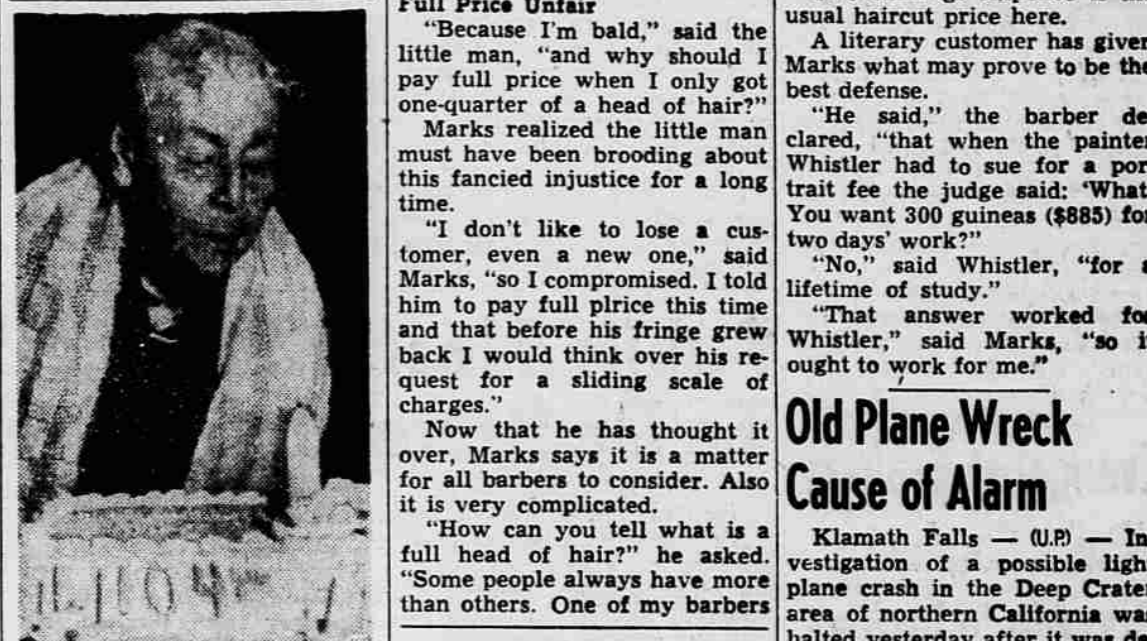

Penleton Culinary Labor Tiff Settled

Penleton — (U.P.) — A strike by some 120 culinary workers in the Penleton area was settled yesterday.

The workers, members of the Culinary and Bartenders local 536 (AFL) of Penleton received their demands for a \$1 an hour minimum wage. The old pay scale was 85 1/2 cents an hour.

The contract also provides for additional holidays. The strike began last Thursday. It affected nine restaurants, two lounges, a bar and a tavern in Penleton. Contracts still were unsigned in some parts of Umatilla county and at Boardman in Morrow county.
