Back in the era of honest medicine—before practice was converted from a profession to a business—medical authorities recognized two kinds of chronic (long lasting) joint trouble, namely, chronic rheumatism and arthritis deformans (sometimes called rheumatoid arthritis).

The foremost medical authority (Osler) opined that "exposure to wet and damp" was a "possible exciting cause" of arthritis deformans, whereas he stated that chronic rheumatism was "most common among the poor, particularly washerwomen, day laborers, and those whose occupation exposes them to cold and damp."

Corn and Callus

A few years ago you gave the recipe for a corn and callus remedy that was most effective. Now I have lost the recipe. . . . (Mrs. J. W. McH.)

Answer—Paint corn or callus (not bunions) daily with a solution of 30 grains of salicylic acid in one-half fluidounce of flexible collodion. In a week or so corn or callus softens so you can wipe it away.

Wreck of Special Logging Truck Fatal

Lebanon, Ore. — (U.P.) — Stanley Ray, 27, of Lacombe, was killed almost instantly yesterday afternoon when he apparently lost control of his giant specially-built logging truck near here. The truck veered into a ditch and its load of 22 logs sheered off the cab.

The accident occurred on a private road. Ray's rig apparently bounced when it crossed Beaver creek bridge, causing the driver to lose control.

Coroner Glenn Huston said Ray actually died of strangulation when he was trapped by the logs with his neck against the steering wheel. The \$52,000 truck, which can only operate on private roads, was demolished.
