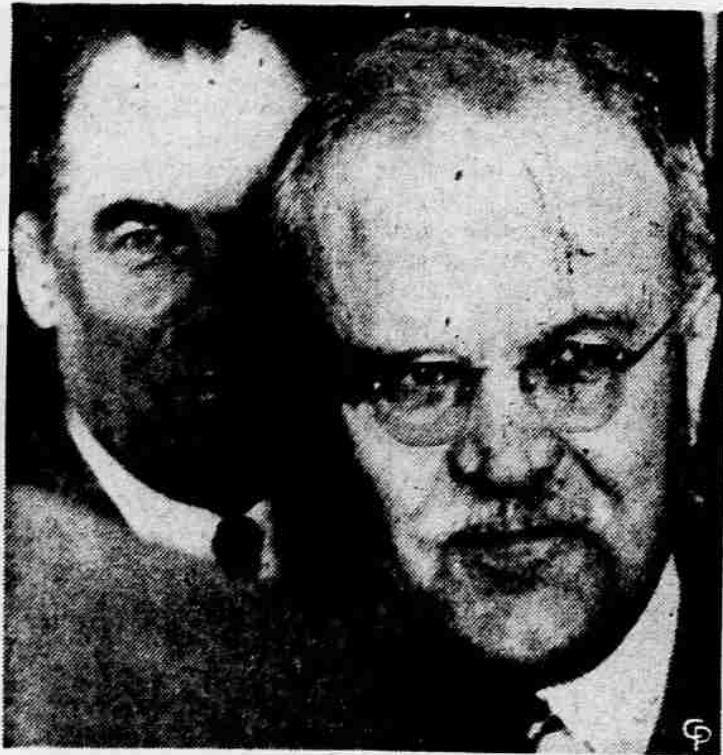

School Elections Set Monday; Under Half Will Be Contested

Less than half of the district school board elections in Jackson county, scheduled for Monday, June 20, will be contested, a check showed today.

Each of the county's 20 second and third class districts will be electing at least three directors under a new state law which increases their school boards from three to five members.

The county's three first class districts, Medford, Ashland, and District 6C, which includes Central Point, Gold Hill, and Sams Valley, already have five-member school boards and will be electing only one director.

Candidates Listed

Lists of candidates have been received by the county schools office from 21 out of the county's 23 school districts. No reports have been received from Pinehurst and Ashland.

The candidates in each district are:

Jacksonville: Three-year term—Floyd Wyatt. Four-year term—Russell McIntyre. Five-year term—B. J. Christianson.

Griffin Creek: Three-year term—Chester Guch and Joe Casad. Four-year term—Mrs. Roy Sander and Edward Mathern. Five-year term—Galen Knox.

Ruch: Three-year term—Edmund Ramsay and J. S. Larson. Four-year term—George Sample and Milton Houston. Five-year term—Robert Webb.

Phoenix: Three-year term—J. Curtis Barnes and Harold

Bids Will Be Asked For Dalles Dam Job

Portland (U.P.)—Bids for the final major construction work at The Dalles dam, a closure dam, will be invited about July 11, according to the Portland district, Corps of Engineers.

Col. James U. Moorhead, district engineer, said the closure dam was expected to cost approximately \$10,000,000. The facility will make possible the closure of the Columbia river.

One other large contract remains to be let after the river closure item, the colonel said, for installation of equipment in the dam powerhouse.

First power on the line from The Dalles dam is scheduled for November, 1957. The dam will have an initial capacity of 1,222,000 kilowatts, generated by 14 main units and two fishwater units.

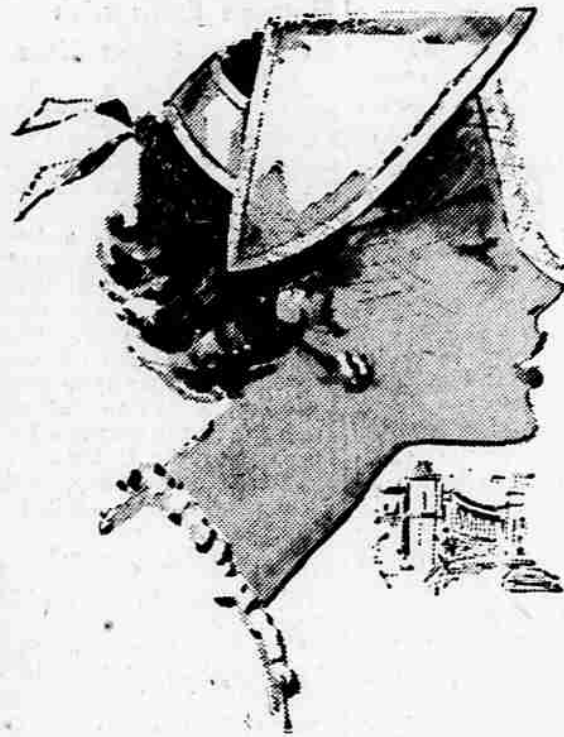

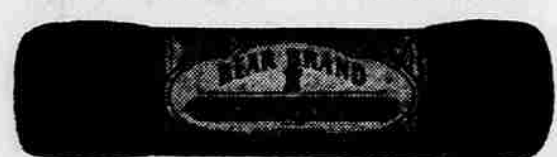
