#### CHAMOMILE TEA FOR VARICOSE ULCER

A reader says he has Ben Told Hungarian chamomile tea is good for varicose ulcer. He tried it, and it healed an ulcer on his ankle which his doctor had treated with various salves without success. Now the man's wife is drinking chamomile tea—Hungarian, probably—which she says the old-timers used for babies' upset stomach when grandma was a filly. It seems to do her good too!

In the pamphlet *Varicose Veins and Varicose Ulcer*, available on written, signed request if you provide stamped, self-addressed envelope, I say: A simple home treatment that gives much relief and speeds healing of varicose ulcer is salted chamomile tea.

Steep a handful of dried chamomile flowers (called variously Hungarian, German, English, Roman) in a quart of water in which two level teaspoonfuls of salt is dissolved. Keep the raw surface constantly covered with gauze (washed cheesecloth) compresses or folds wet with the tea, for 48 hours or longer. At night cover the wet dressing with waxed paper or other water proof material to keep clothing dry. This chamomile tea dressing is especially soothing when ulcer is painful.

There's no harm in the habit of indulging in a dish of tea—green, black, oolong, cambric or chamomile—when one of the neighbors drops in with a spicy bit of gossip, but I do not recommend it.

A wet dressing of green or black tea is excellent for burns, as an emergency dressing or as a regular daily treatment. A handy preparation for first aid application to burns is a salve containing 10% tannic acid (the astringent in tea) and 0.5% chlorbutanol, a local anesthetic and antiseptic.
