Defective Firm Tells Of Year's Operations

Western Detective (Medford Merchant Police) has made a report covering the year July 1, 1954 to July 1, 1955.

It checked an average of 86 business buildings six times a night, seven nights per week. They entered and checked out 26 buildings four times a night throughout the year.

Two hundred seventy-two windows, 81 doors, 16 safes, and 2 vaults were found open. Twenty-one night lights were found off, and two fires discovered. There were 52 armed escorts to banks.

MANY MATURE ADULTS HAVE TETANY

In a preceding piece about tetany I disparaged the recognized medical authorities in my characteristic fashion and advanced my own opinion (it is not a question of nerve or cheek but of honesty) that the disease, if we should call it a disease, is a manifestation of nutritional deficiency—here we go again, fellows and the prevention, relief or cure of the trouble in infant, growing child or mature adult, is simply an optimal daily ration of calcium and vitamin D. And please remember, knuckleheads, an optimal daily ration of calcium and vitamin D is not medicine.

First I carried on an extensive course of research and study (actually it was just study, but slipping in the word "research" makes it more impressive, don't you think?) of the medical literature and found that the medical authorities mostly offer no ideas of their own but just pass along what other authorities have quoted from their predecessors.

Next I pondered what the physiologists regard as the normal functions of calcium, one of which being that it is necessary to regulate excitability of nerves; another being that vitamin D is essential for adequate calcium absorption to occur. U. S. Bank Reports Deposit, Loan Growth

The United States National Bank, Medford branch, reported deposits and loans totalling \$22,062,427 and \$9,933,872.18 respectively for the 12 month period ending June 30. This compares with 1954 figures of \$17,095,658 deposits and \$7,685,523 loans.
