SCIENCE AT WORK

New York (U.P.)-Referring to children with "reading disability"-which afflicts 12 to 15 per cent of all boys only about half that number of girls - two educational psychologists remind us that every little Johnny in the world "is a bundle of cause and affect, each treading on the other's heels.
"Who is to say whether Johnny is fat-hipped because he needs pitying or because he cannot read?" asked Mildred Gignoux Downes and Rita S. Schuman of the Cambridge (Mass.) Educational Services. "Whether he hits other children because he is jealous of his new baby sister, or because he is too fat? Whether he cannot read because of lack of love, or lack of oxygen?"
"A reading disability" in the child is indicated by such things as these:
Letters are reversed so that a chicken comes out kitchen or united becomes untied. Or the child "reads show for slow, hot for shot, up for down, civilian for soldier. And if he does see soldier, he may both read and spell it soldier or shouder?"
Also Spelling
It may show up in his spelling too. They cited this example, from a theme written by an 18-year-old boy:
"The birds sing in the tress. At a signal the moth bird flies up and disappears into the sunrise. The air is fresh and clean and virgin. Tub (but) the mate of the mother is not so luck. With a beautiful, bitful middle in his throat he dies from the blast of our gun. The crows lies in a demoralizing blooby mess."
They asked people to accept "mind, body, and social behavior as continuous and profoundly related expressions of the entire person." What behavior seems to go with reading disability? They said "the young person hates to read. He panics in a test. He may stammer or send up other signals of tension like knee-jerking, nailbiting, paper-tearing, face-fussing, hair-pulling (both his own and that of other students)."
"Before six the child learned, or failed to learn, by hearing," they said. "At about seven he began to learn, or not to learn, by reading. The child who has determined to have no truck with grown-ups and their stern world may protect himself from understanding the written word by a 'disability,' as he has already protected himself from understanding the spoken word by a psychic deafness.
"Me and Now"
"Any year, even up to the age of 60, he may turn up in a reading clinic. Even if he limped somehow through college, his disability undiagnosed, he may continue all his life to avoid books, to 'read too slowly,' to 'concentrate poorly,' and to 'fear he may miss something,' with the result that he does a superb job of self-sabotage. He reads so slowly that he misses almost everything."
The two psychologists were lecturing physicians, by invitation, in the New England Journal of Medicine on a psychological ailment which is only now being generally recognized and about which present understanding still is less than complete. However, this they stated with complete certainty:
"These disabled readers, more often than not, cannot force themselves as any kind of a whole adult. They envisage no future, no success, no pattern. They do not project themselves as citizens, as earners, as spouses or as parents. For them there is only an insulated bit of time and a temporary island of personality: me and now."
