Mrs. John Day Appointed To Red Cross Area Council

Announcement of the appointment of Mrs. John S. Day to the Pacific area council of the Red Cross was received here last week from the national headquarters at Washington, D.C. The area includes the nine western states and Alaska. The appointment is for a period of three years.

Mrs. Day received her first training in Red Cross work during the beginning years of World War II and first qualified in 1952. She was staff aide chairman from 1942 to 1949.

Since 1949 Mrs. Day has been a member of the Veterans Administration Volunteer services in the Medford-Roseburg council. She was chairman of volunteer services for about four years and has recruited full staff for all services.

More than 200 active volunteers work under her chairmanship at least one day a week, in 15 different services.

Other offices held by Mrs. Day include chairman from 1951 to 1952 of the blood bank program, and vice-chairman of the chapter since 1946.

She also is active in Jackson County health services, is president of the Cancer society, is active in League of Women Voters, Republican Women's organization, Junior Service league and Girl Scout activities.
