Larger Potato Crop Seen for West States

Portland (U.P.) — This year's late summer potato crop in five Western states is expected to show an eight per cent increase over last year's crop, according to the U. S. Department of Agriculture marketing news service.

Oregon, Idaho, Washington, California and Colorado are expected to produce a combined yield of 25,875,000 bushels of potatoes, compared to last year's crop of 24,926,000 bushels. Oregon's late summer crop was forecast at 4,030,000 bushels, slightly above last year's production.

The fall crop of potatoes is estimated to be 18 per cent more than last year. Oregon's predicted fall crop, 9,960,000, would be 620,000 bushels over production last fall.

The marketing service said onion production in the five western states would be about nine per cent below average. Cold weather in Oregon and Washington contributed to the decline.
