### Oregon Now Second Tree Farm State

Washington-Oregon has just passed Washington to become second among the 38 states in the American Tree Farm program, according to the American Forest Products Industries, national coordinator of the Tree Farm movement.

The Oregon total is 3,258,959 acres compared to 3,231,608 acres in Washington state. Only Texas with 3,438,970 acres, has more land certified as Tree Farms.

Tree Farms are private forest lands, of any size, dedicated to growing timber crops as a business. More than 33 per cent of all Oregon's privately-owned commercial forest land is already in certified Tree Farm status.

The greatest distance west to east in the U. S. is 3,100 miles. The north to south maximum is 1,700 miles.
