Education Compact Group Will Meet; Van Dyke Attending

Frank J. Van Dyke, Medford attorney, will attend the annual meeting of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education at Cheyenne, Wyoming, Aug. 8.

Van Dyke is one of three commissioners for Oregon appointed by the governor of the commission, a 10-state and one territory organization which coordinates the exchange of professional students in medicine, veterinary medicine, and dentistry. Last year more than 100 students from states which do not have facilities in these fields crossed state borders under auspices of the compact.

Two Study Projects

In its role as a fact-finding agency, the Commission currently has two study projects—one in mental health under a \$61,000 grant from the National Institute of Mental Health in the fields of psychiatry, clinical psychology, psychiatric nursing, and psychiatric social work, and the other in dental manpower through cooperative efforts with the U. S. public health service, the Kellogg foundation and the American Dental association.

Organized in 1951 and approved by President Eisenhower in 1954, the commission has welcomed California, Washington, and Alaska into its membership during the current year.

At Cheyenne Van Dyke will participate in discussions concerning expansion of the program to other fields. On Sunday he will be a guest of Gov. Milward Simpson at a reception in the governor's mansion.
