

Russia To Support Satellite Project

Moscow — (U.P.) — Communist Party Secretary Nikita Khrushchev said yesterday Russia will support America's project to shoot an artificial Earth satellite into space if it is "in the interest of humanity."

Khrushchev was asked for his views on the American space satellite plan by a newspaper correspondent at a Swiss Embassy reception.

"If it is in the interest of humanity we will never refuse either our aid or our cooperation," the party secretary replied.

"But," he went on, "it is difficult for me to discuss this question although I have heard about it. I have not yet read the text of the American announcement, and I am not an expert in this field."

Screaming Baby Sitter Frightens Burglar

Deserted Dogs

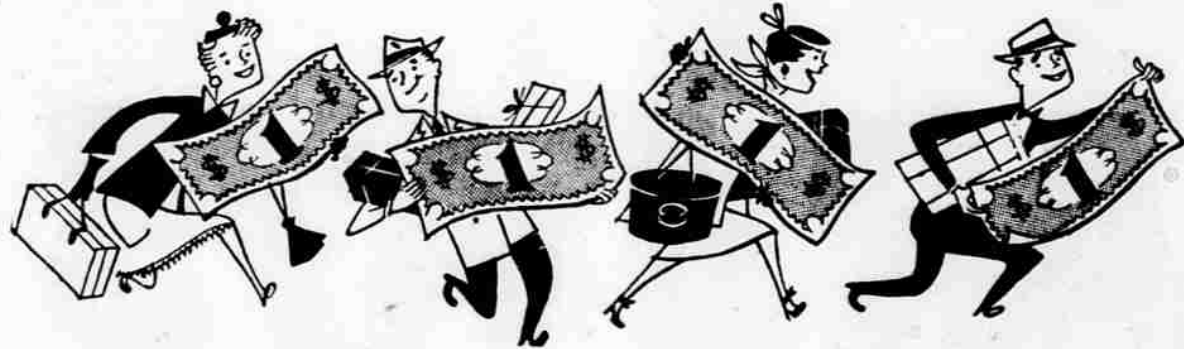

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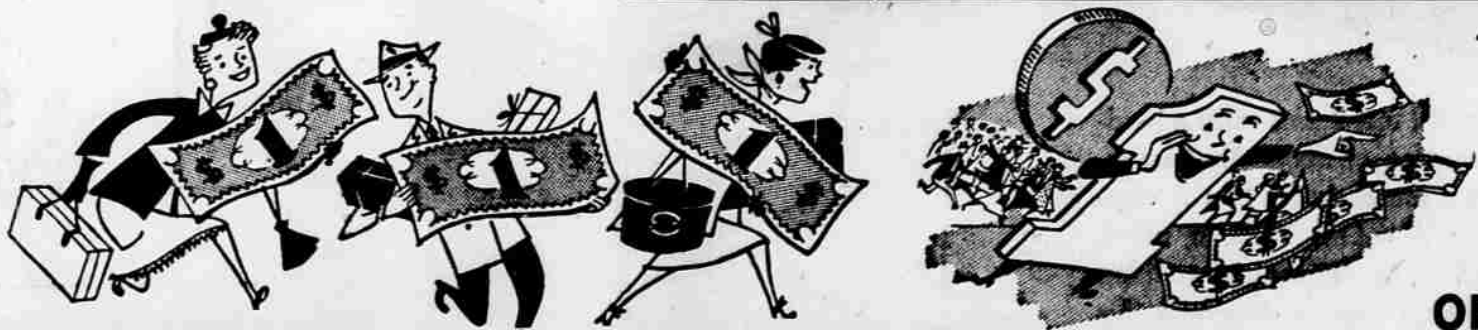
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
