Harriman Predicts Eisenhower Defeat

New York —(U.P.)—Gov. Averell Harriman predicted Monday night that President Eisenhower will be defeated if he seeks reelection despite his personal popularity.

Harriman, himself considered a possible Democratic candidate for the presidency, said that the President has retained his popularity because of an ability to "disassociate himself with his associates."

"But," the governor said, "when it comes to a campaign, it's impossible for a candidate to divorce himself from his associates. Harriman said an Eisenhower reelection bid would be unsuccessful because of 'the failures of the people around him.'"

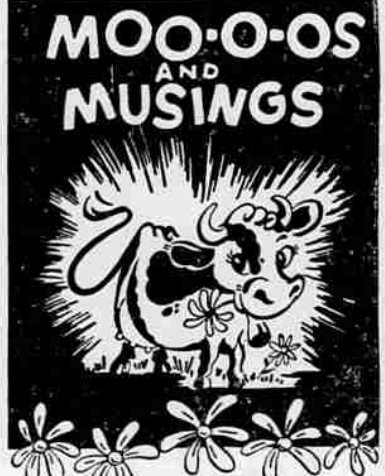
"The people are swinging away from the Republican party and therefore will swing away from the leader of that party when election time comes next year," Harriman said.

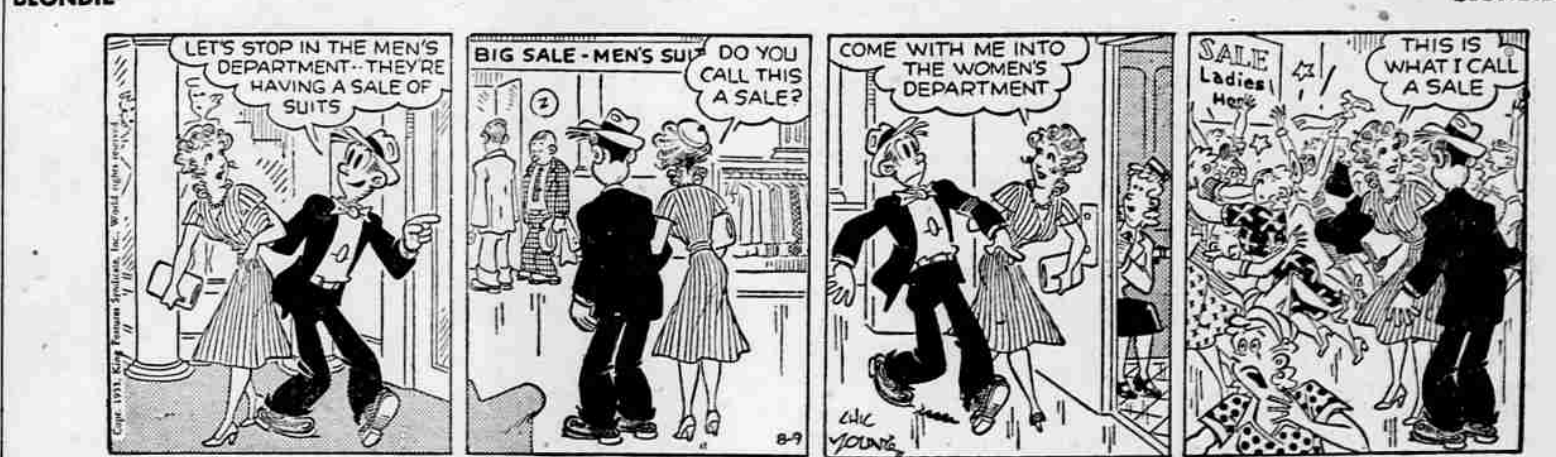
