Iowa Man Expects To Become Airborne With Parachute, Balloons

Burlington, Ia. — (UP) — Art Hartman, 67, Burlington, plans to go airborne this summer with a parachute, a bicycle and 200 small helium balloons.

With a good tail wind he figures he can zip along at 25 to 30 miles per hour at an altitude of about 1500 feet.

Generally a parachute is the slow way down from an aircraft and a bicycle is strictly ground level. But the spry Iowan has blended them into what he calls the "Hartman Flying Saucer."

Give Balloonist

Hartman always has had difficulty keeping at least one foot on the ground. He's still an active balloonist and plans to make at least eight ascensions this summer. He's a former trapeze performer and has parachuted for pay about 500 times.

"The 'Flying Saucer' is something that has kicked around in the back of Hartman's mind since 1907.

That year Hartman had a balloon entered in an air show at St. Louis but the fellow who sailed away with the \$10,000 first prize was a 15-year-old Ohioan identified as Cromwell Dixon.

"Dixon flew a circle with his balloon, guiding it with flappers connected to bicycle pedals," Hartman said. "It was one of the neatest tricks I've ever seen."

Hartman has used Dixon's principle to construct his bicycle-balloon. He's ready for the maiden flight, needing only a sponsor.

Frame Suspended

Under a 28-foot parachute Hartman will place 200 balloons filled with helium. The frame of the bicycle is suspended under the balloons, the pedals operat-

ing a propeller in front and a tail fin in back.

"There's no question but what it will fly," Hartman said. "To come down, I'll release the balloons one by one."

Hartman is dickering with officials of the Texas State Fair at Dallas and another group at Amarillo. The Civil Aeronautics Administration has given its approval.

The elderly daredevil estimated it will cost \$400 to take the contraption up. "That's why I can't give any demonstration," he said.

"But when I'm lined up to give a show, I'll take her anyplace. The going rate is 10 cents a mile—even from here to the coast."

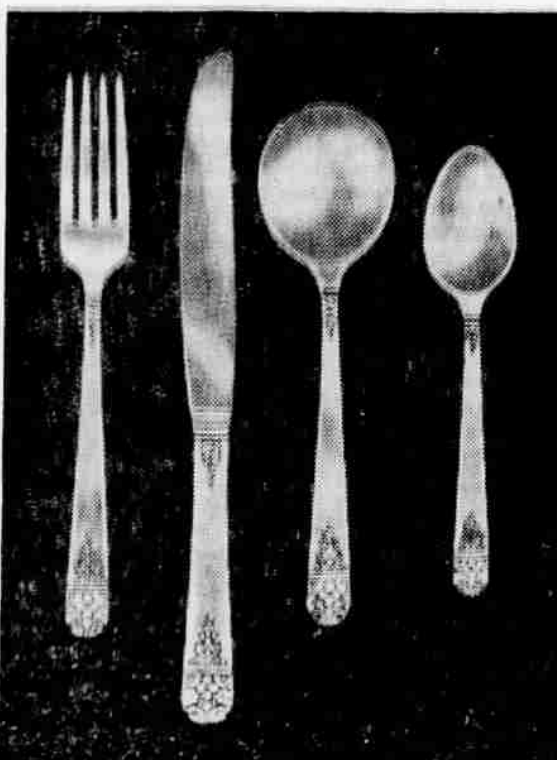
