Hollywood—(U.P.)—Of all the pictures on which I've worked during the last 20 years as a makeup man, none posed as many problems as "Helen of Troy" and "Land of the Pharaohs," both of which were shot from my home studio in Burbank.

I guess I'm the only makeup man ever to brandish a powder puff and makeup brush in Rome and Cairo while sitting at a desk on the Warner Bros. lot.

It was like trying to direct traffic in New York while sitting in front of a TV screen in Los Angeles. But it had to be done. I was the man responsible for the long-range supervision of makeup on both pictures.

Greeks and Trojans

After viewing the rushes, I would cable or phone the head makeup man on location with either picture and would dictate changes in color, shade and texture of makeup.
