Rhythm' Determines Growth of Seedlings

Berkeley, Calif. — (U.P.) — A California forester has discovered that evergreen seedlings have an internal "rhythm" which determines whether they will produce the strong roots needed for transplanting to Christmas tree forests.

The forester, Edward C. Stone, has been trying to find an answer to the 50 per cent loss of seedlings which occurs when they are transplanted.

The high rate of loss has proved the principal obstacle to California's Christmas tree industry and has been holding back re-development of the state's forests and private timber growths.

By experiment with seedlings in the University of California's greenhouse, Stone hopes to establish the natural growth cycle that best fits a seedling for survival in California, thus raising the survival rate to 85 or 90 per cent.

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Back Stairs: Ike's Colorful Clothes

Denver — (U.P.) — Backstairs at the summer White House:

It may be just the vacation atmosphere or it might have been the absence of Mrs. Eisenhower's restraining influence.

But in any case, President Eisenhower has exhibited as never before his liking for colorful, comfortable clothes while on his work-and-play vacation.

The first day back from his five-day sojourn at Fraser, Colo., the President showed up at his office in a bright yellow shirt, crepe-soled shoes, a brownish nubby weave summer sports jacket, tan slacks, maroon socks and a figured tie.

At Fraser, he leaned toward bright plaid sports shirts—one a dazzling red, green and yellow.

He also turned up tieless one day at the summer White House at Lowry Air Force Base in a blue and watermelon colored sports shirt. And a favorite golfing costume is a symphony of mild blues, from cap to slacks.

The President especially likes comfortable shoes. He frequently wore a pair of buckskin moccasins around the vacation ranch. The white leather, crepe-soled oxfords make easy walking around the air base and the home of his mother-in-law, Mrs. John S. Doud.

The Byers Peak ranch of Akel Nielsen, where the President stays near Fraser, took on a "new look" in many ways when the President's 7-year-old grandson, David, shared Mr. Eisenhower's fishing vacation.

The few automobiles admitted to the ranch's narrow, impaved road were greeted by the warning sign:

"Slow, watch for children."

One of the outbuildings on the ranch bore a newly-painted sign over the door: "Woodshed."

But the President didn't have to use it during David's visit.

The sharpest, neatest air police squad at Lowry has the honor of designating just when the President is on or off the base.

A large ceremonial flag, twice the size of the regular ensign that flies in front of the summer White House headquarters building, is hoisted a few minutes before the President's arrival each morning. A few minutes after his departure, the huge flag is lowered and replaced by what Virginia-born Maj. Gen. John T. Sraque, base commander calls the "everyday" flag.
