Historic Lighthouse Now Museum Park

Highlands, N. J.—(U.P.)—Historic old lighthouses have a notoriously high mortality rate in this day of radar and sea-based lights.
But there's one here, Navisink Lighthouse, which not only got a reprieve to become part of an historical park, but which served the cause of air navigation while awaiting conservation to a relic.
The sharp departure from the landmark's role in the 19th century came when New York University's College of Engineering sent scientists from its research division to set up a site for research in air-sea horizon photography.
Nine months and 3,000 photos after the research began, the Sperry Gyroscope Co. sponsor of the studies, used the material to help provide an accurate method of photographing the horizon as a check on pitch and roll angles of aircraft.
Now the old tower which has been the scene of Guglielmo Marconi's first demonstration of wireless in the United States and secret radar tests during

World War II, is in the hands of the Highlands citizenry.
It will become, in its deserved retirement, an historical monument and marine museum with surrounding park.

MALNUTRITION AND PAINFUL CRAMPS
In a recent piece in this column the quack (self-convinced by the piece) who has conducted the column since the credulous editor in northern Minnesota planted him "under the sod" told why he ascribes the leg pains and cramps of persons of mature age, especially extremely painful cramps that come in the night, to tetany.
Today I received a letter from a Kentucky reader who asks for my pamphlet on tetanus. From the description (July 9) in my column, he is convinced that the cramps he suffers at night must be from tetanus.
Part of my daily prayer—and I mean prayer—is this: Lord, let me write nothing that will do anybody harm.
On reading over the master copy (the piece in printed form as it is supplied six days in every week) released for July 9, I find I called it tetany. I was afraid some copy reader might have corrected what he or she considered an obvious error by changing tetany to tetanus.
This confusion of tetanus (lockjaw) with tetany (malnutrition) by a reader who obviously is well-educated, as educators go, even if her teachers carefully shielded her from knowledge of such nasty subjects as physiology, hygiene and the like, is disturbing. It makes me wonder why I mentioned tetany in what purports to be a health column.
For that matter, tetany is not familiar even to physicians, and one seldom finds mention of it in current medical literature. Somehow the medical profession was misled by some old-timer's theory that tetany was due to functional deficiency of the parathyroid glands (four small ductless glands close to but distinct from the thyroid), although feeding or injecting extracts of parathyroid as treatment has given no particular benefit. Still medical textbooks continue to suggest parathyroid extract as a remedy for "infantile spasmodic" the favorite medicalese for tetany.
For doctors who like to keep things complicated and beyond ordinary comprehension, it is entirely too simple to regard tetany whether in infant or mature adult, as a manifestation of nutritional deficiency—"malnutrition" as it is otherwise called.
But that's the way a lot of you kn—your poor souls like it complicated. It justifies you getting shots of this and that.
For my own sake I don't care, for I'm really missing a lot of bowling by staying on this job, but for your sake I'd be sorry if I got the sack for telling the truth about the ways of health.
I have studied this question intensively and for many years, and I am as certain as one can be about any ailment that tetany in infant or adult is due to long continued calcium and vitamin D deficiency.

Pork Good Food Buy, Farm Price Report Shows
Washington — (U.P.) — Housewives can take a tip from the Agriculture Department's current farm price report—pork is a good food buy now.
The department noted in its report yesterday that prices farmers got for hogs during the month which ended Aug. 15 were down 26 per cent from a year ago. And with this year's spring pig crop, 9 per cent up from last year's, now beginning to come to market, prices are likely to retreat even further in the next few months.

Secondary Rank Asked For Clear Lake Cut-Off
Bend — (U.P.) — Central Oregon and upper Willamette valley towns have asked the State Highway commission to include the new Clear Lake cut-off as a secondary route in the state highway system.
The cut-off links the McKenzie and Santiam highways west of the Cascade divide, providing a year-round route from central Oregon to Eugene.
Robert Aufderheide, supervisor of Willamette National forest, said the Forest Service had already requested that the new route be designated a state secondary highway.

Fong Murder Retrial Scheduled Sept. 28
Portland — (U.P.) — Wey Him and Sherry Fong will be retried on a first degree murder charge on Sept. 28, according to tentative plans announced by Howard L. Loneragan, chief criminal deputy district attorney.
The Fongs were convicted last spring of the murder of 16-year-old Diane Hank and sentenced to life imprisonment. The presiding judge, Alfred P. Dobson, later upheld the verdict and ordered a new trial.
Also set for trial in September were state cases against two fathers accused of assaults on their infant sons, Earl R. Johnson, 29,
