Wisconsin Vegetable Packing Leads U.S.

Madison, Wis. —(U.P.)— Wisconsin has consistently led the nation in packing vegetables for market, the Wisconsin Canner's Association reports, with some 30,000 acres in gardens which produce one-fifth of the nation's pack.

The Wisconsin pack totals almost as much as is produced in the rest of the world outside the United States. The state is the largest producer in this country of canned peas, sweet corn, beets and carrots. In sauerkraut and cucumber pickles, it ranks second.

Green Bay, Wis. —(U.P.)— Diver Wayne Truttman has solved the mystery of a "sea monster" which had been reported by several sober, reliable persons, including sheriff's deputies on duty.

A Fool and His Arthritis

Mind, now, credulous one, I do not say that chronic arthritis may not happen now and then, although no medical authority, so far as I am aware, sustains by sound pathology a diagnosis of "chronic arthritis" as a specific ailment.

I do say, and I think I can sustain this statement with sound pathology, that in most cases purporting to be "chronic arthritis," there is not now and there has not been any indication of inflammation of the joint tissues (except from accidental cause) and therefore the joint disability is not "arthritis" at all. In at least nine cases out of ten, joint disability of more than a year in duration is actually what I call rheumatiz, rheumatiz, if you please, not rheumatism.

I'm sorry about the word, but I've learned by experience how difficult it is to persuade people to use a new word or to correct wrong use of an old one. Probably 99 out of a 100 readers do not use the words *crisis* and *vite* and have no idea what the words mean. And it took many years to persuade newspaper people to quit calling *amnesia* *aphasia*.

Nevertheless, I hope every reader with joint disability of long duration will send me a stamped, self-addressed envelope and ask for the pamphlet *Calcium and Rheumatiz*. Please do so, even if you have been through the best advertised clinic or are being treated for "arthritis" by a specialist.

The common kind of joint disability I call rheumatiz develops insidiously. It creeps up on you. Except from accident or strain there is nothing inflammatory about the joint trouble, just a gradual development of soreness, lameness, pain and disability through a period of months or years. In short, the trouble is physical degeneration of joint tissues.

For that matter, as a student of, though by no means an authority on pathology, I question the validity of the concept of chronic inflammation in any circumstance. In every such instance, the actual condition, I believe, is not inflammation at all, but degeneration. If I'm wrong about this, I'll be grateful to physician or pathologist who can or will set me right—and needless to say, I'll never reveal the identity of such mentor without his or her written consent.

Degeneration is thus defined in Stedman's Medical Dictionary: A retrogressive pathological change in cells or tissues in consequence of which the functioning power is lost and the living substance becomes converted into an inert mass. (Dr. Stedman meant to say the functioning power is impaired, I'm sure.)

As I indicate in the pamphlet, the cause of the joint degeneration which I call rheumatiz is nutritional deficiency through the years from early childhood

up to and including bedtime snack tonight. That is to say, insufficient daily intake of calcium, sunshine vitamin D, vitamin B complex and iodine.

Townpeople Plan On Move To New Town

Pollock, S. D. —(U.P.)— The 50 some residents of Pollock are getting ready for a mass move. A new town is being constructed a mile south of the present community, and before another year is past the old town will be deserted.

The townspeople are being moved because the present site will be flooded by a Missouri River reservoir which will be backed up behind the world's largest earth-fill rolled dam at Pierre, some 200 miles to the south. The new town is expected to

be a bigger and better community than the old one. For instance, the old town did not have a water and sewer system, but the new one will. The federal government is footing most of the bill.

Construction of the new town already is underway. Residents have picked out their lots, and the moving and construction of homes is expected to start this summer.

There are indications the new town—with its modern facilities—will attract many new residents, mostly retired farmers of the area, and several new businesses.

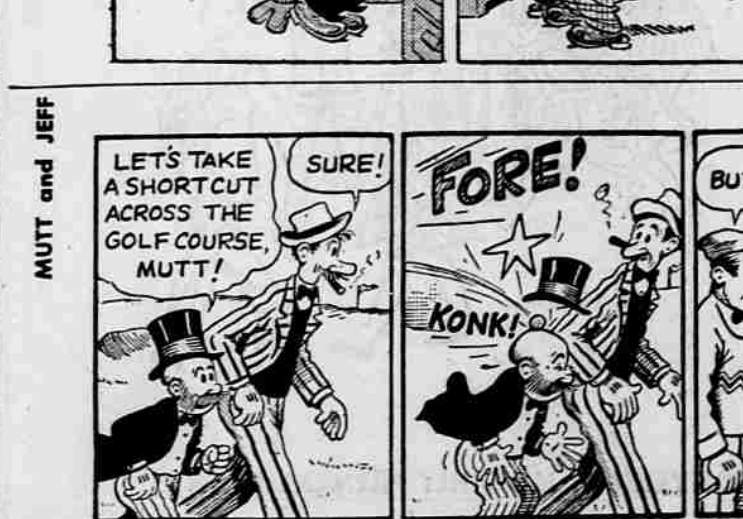

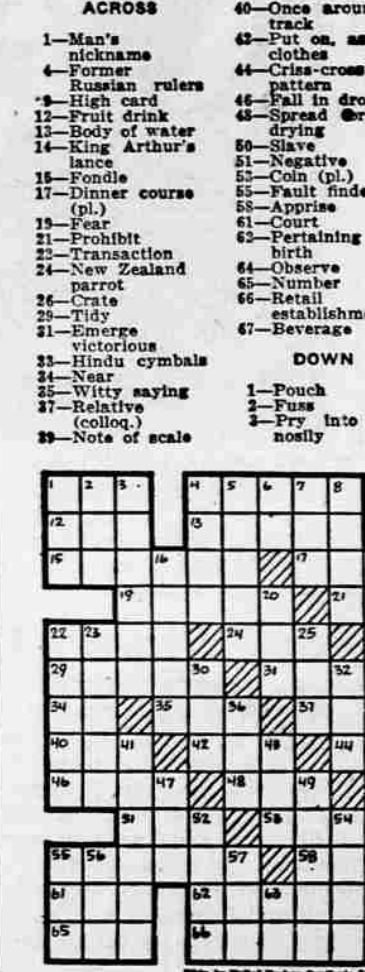
