'Pay-Up-and-Sue' Is House's Suggestion

Chicago—(U.P.)—Federal tax-payers who are assessed added amounts by the internal revenue commissioner would do well to follow a "pay-up-and-sue" policy, Commerce Clearing House said.

The clearing house said more than half the taxpayers who followed that policy got their money back with interest when they paid their alleged deficiencies, then sued for refunds in federal district courts.

Taxpayers who applied for

relief to the U. S. tax court, where pre-trial payment is not required, did not fare so well. The clearing house said that the commissioner's deficiency assessments were upheld, either totally or partially, in three out of four cases.

Subsequent appeals from the tax court to appellate courts also went against taxpayers, at a rate of three to two.

Seoul, Korea—(U.P.)—Yang You Chan, Republic of Korea Ambassador to the United States, has arrived here amid reports he would be offered the post of foreign minister. Yang declined to comment on the reports until he confers with ROK President Syngman Rhee.

I HEAR THIS STORY EVERY DAY

Exasperated. Sarcastic. Unsympathetic. Undignified. Name-calling. Faultfinding. I'm all of these, and then some, they tell me.

Why don't I feed people a little syrup, butter, or soft soap with my medicine, as do the eminent doctors who manage to take time out from business to write pieces for the papers?

I have no answer. Maybe it is because I'm such a stinker under the hard shell.

In extenuation I'd like to leave this statement in my cell, when they come for me at sunrise.

For many years I have tried to keep my spirits and my professional pride high, despite the efforts of the AMA, under the rule of the late Pooh-Bah, to destroy both. When the dictator, having grabbed for himself whatever he wanted, consented to retire with a "pension" that would support a doz-

en families in comfort, I found one consolation—that at any rate I would not help pay that pension, for I had let my membership in the AMA lapse the year before, in the only way a member or fellow can "resign," by ceasing to pay my annual dues. I had paid my dues for about 40 years but nausea finally stopped me.

From the end of the Fishbein era to date the most spectacular achievement of the AMA seems to be that the organization is no

longer selling cigarettes—a sideline which made a lot of folding money while the Pooh-Bah was in the saddle.

which were mostly affected. Then it seems something happened. After taking six pills a day and then two a day, under doctor's direction, for nearly 10 weeks, I suddenly had a relapse and all the stiffness, aches and pains returned worse than ever. Why...?"

Indeed I am sorry for people who have this experience with the "wonder" or "miracle" drugs. There's nothing I can do about it but warn them not to expect a happy ending of the joy ride if or when they choose to undergo treatment with such drugs.

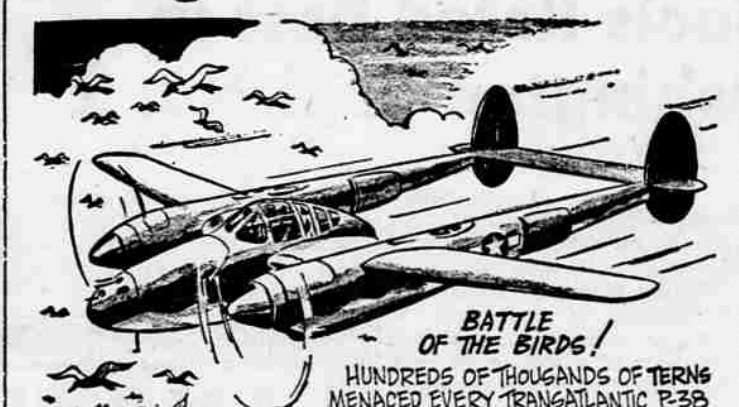
