Around Hollywood

Hollywood—(U.P.)—Alec Guinness, the sly English comedian, gets both stardom and Grace Kelly in his first Hollywood picture, but he modestly calls himself "just an ordinary character actor."

Guinness has the distinction of being a foreign star who has become a top comedian with U.S. fans because of his polished, wonderful comedies such as "The Lavender Hill Mob" and "King Hearts and Coronets."

At last the actor has been lured to Hollywood for the film version of the Ferenc Molnar play, "The Swan." He not only gets the girl in passionate love scenes, but she's Grace Kelly, the top prize of the Hollywoods. He's welcomed.

Hollywood also rolled out a red welcome carpet for Guinness with a cocktail party, and Miss Kelly gave a soiree at her home in his honor.

But the solemn-faced actor waves all this acclaim aside.

"I'm just an ordinary character actor," Guinness said humbly.

"I've been an actor for 22 years. I do dramas, too, and stage work."

"I don't get much fan mail—I'm not that kind of an actor. Any notice I've had in this country is indeed a mystery to me, as it is to people back home."

Guinness sat in his Beverly Hills hotel suite, a colorful sight in a long, black, baggy sweater and muffer and minus his usual toupee. He often sniffled and blew his nose because of a cold the Londoner picked up from the California sunshine.

His favorite comedian, he went on, is Hollywood's Buster Keaton. Guinness even seems surprised that many film critics regard England's comedies as superior to Hollywood's.

Guinness was asked before to come to Hollywood but, he explained, "the scripts were usually imitations of stuff I've done back home."

"Or else I was committed for English films," he said. "I'm supposed to be doing a film in England right now. But three weeks ago it suddenly fell through, and I was left high and dry. Within 24 hours this 'Swan' comedy turned up with the role of an

amusing character."

In "The Swan," Guinness plays a Hungarian prince who is not too interested in the sleek Miss Kelly until Louis Jordan nearly sweeps her away.

Hollywood Ending

Already there's a plot afoot in the inner sanctum of MGM to Hollywoodize that Molnar ending. If sneak preview audiences don't dig Guinness' romantic appeal, a new non-Molnar finish will be filmed in which Jourdan wins the fair lady.

Guinness arrived in Hollywood on an over-the-north-pole airliner. This trip featured a scene right out of a Guinness movie.

"I had a berth, but it jacked-knifed and collapsed," he said. "I didn't want to wake my fellow passengers. So I spent the night with my feet and head up in the air and the rest of me hanging down below."

WHY TOENAILS DIE

Could you tell me, asks a Boston lady, eh, why toenails die. I go to trim mine and they come off in my hand, particularly the great toe and the middle one. (Mrs. W.L.A.)

Maybe it's because we don't use 'em anymore.

The finger nails, toe nails, skin and hair are all subject to the individual's nutritional condition, and they get all their nourishment or food as every other part of the body does, from the food one eats, not from any magic cream, oil or other stuff you apply or "rub in," nitwit.

One who has VITE has healthy nails, skin and hair. But you can't get or maintain vite on a diet of cheat-food—a diet in which most of the calories are in refined white flour and refined white sugar.
