

Japanese Minister To Speak Sunday; Public Is Invited

Ashland—The Rev. Kiyoshi Tanimoto of Hiroshima, Japan, who is currently receiving nationwide attention as sponsor of the "Hiroshima Maidens" will speak at the First Methodist church, Ashland, on Friday, Oct. 7 at 7:30 p.m.

The "Hiroshima Maidens" are twenty-five girls of Hiroshima, Japan, disfigured by the atomic blast, and now are receiving plastic surgery in the United States.

Leading Figure

The Rev. Mr. Tanimoto first became known to the people of the United States when the story of his heroic relief efforts at the time of the bombing of Hiroshima were told in John Hershey's best seller, "Hiroshima". Since then Rev. Mr. Tanimoto has been a leading figure in the development of the Hiroshima Peace center.
