Personal Health Service

Recently I wrote you regarding the remarkable sun tan lotion which I guarantee... notwithstanding your assertion that it is absurd to imagine anything that will let a person tan at the same time prevent sunburn, I can prove... (No address).

I am a medical student at... and I have been taught that a salt-free diet is often helpful in the control of hypertension. In your article you said that the effect of excessive salt consumption on blood pressure, in scientifically controlled tests, is insignificant. I would appreciate it if you would cite the source of the "scientifically controlled" tests... (Properly signed).

"It has been reported that if iodine or iodide is used beyond a certain point it may produce undesirable or dangerous effects..." I would like to know your opinion... (A. M.).

In the pamphlet "The Iodine Ratio" available on written request (clipping will not suffice) if you provide stamped, self-addressed envelope, I give my advice concerning the use of iodine in nutrition. The use of iodine or iodide as medicine is best left to the judgment of your physician.

I'm sorry I haven't the reference the medical student asks for, and anyway, if the student's teacher or professor says salt-free diet or salt-poor diet is beneficial to a person with high blood pressure, the professor's opinion is as good as any other doctor's opinion, even as good as mine, so why fash ourselves about it?

Incidentally, the medical student may be interested to know, advising patients to avoid or restrict their intake of foods containing much cholesterol is, in my opinion, without scientific foundation—but it makes an impression on the Yankee Wiseacres.

For the person or firm that sent four pages of sales talk about a sun tan lotion I repeat that in my opinion anything that prevents sunburn prevents tanning. Sunburn and tan are both due to the ultraviolet rays in sunshine or skylight or in the light from a therapeutic lamp, so any covering or application that protects against burning must also retard or prevent tanning. U. S. Renews Demand For Prisoner Data

Geneva — (U.P.) — The United States has renewed demands on Communist China for information on the fate of nearly 500 American servicemen missing in the Korean war.

The talks between the ambassadors of the United States and Communist China, which resulted in the release of a number of Americans from Red China, went into the 10th week today.

The United States was standing fast on questions it wants to discuss before considering Peiping's suggestions for a meeting between the foreign ministers.
