

Delta Park Site Opposition Mounts

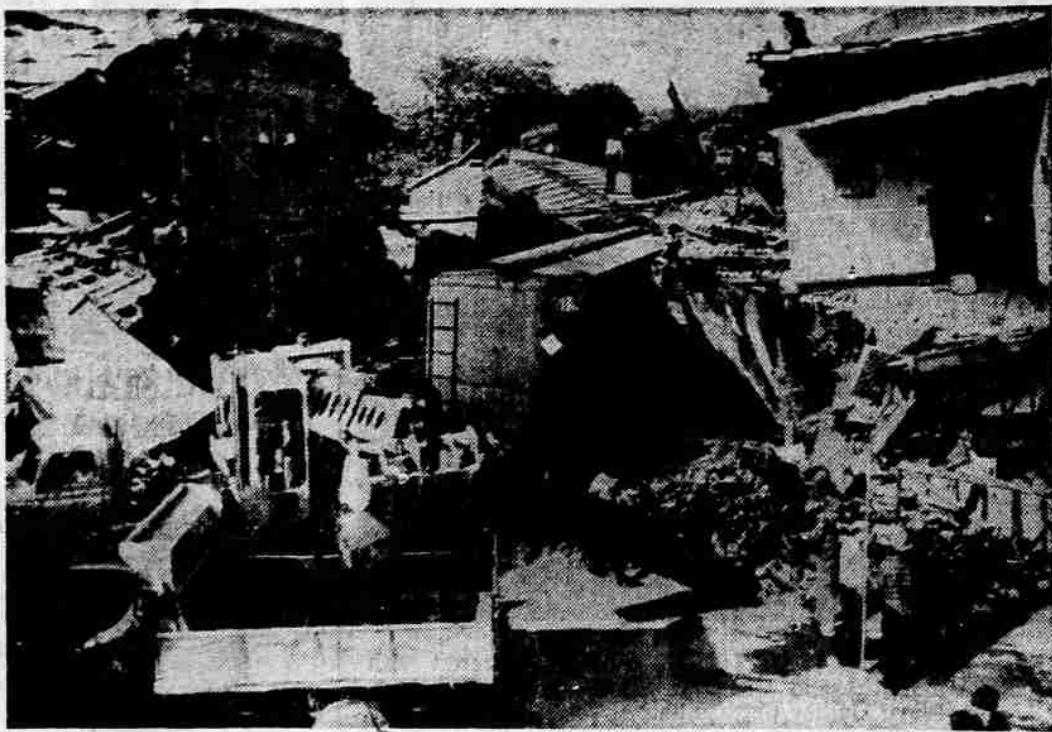
Portland — (U.P.) — Selection of another site for Portland's proposed \$8,000,000 exposition-recreation center appeared possible today after three city commissioners yesterday expressed opposition to Delta Park.

The Delta Park, or Vanport site, was recommended Wednesday by a 3-2 vote of exposition commission members.

However, Commissioners William A. Bowes, Stanley W. Earl and Nathan A. Boody said they would definitely oppose the transfer of Delta Park from the city park bureau to the exposition-recreation commission.

City Attorney Alexander G. Brown said the city council had the authority to veto the commission's choice of a site.

Commissioner Earl said reports on the site by engineers and research institutes showed the Delta Park site "would be a tragic mistake and not in the interests of the general welfare."

Three Men Change Pleas to Guilty

Three men changed pleas of innocent to guilty and received fines in district court Tuesday, on charges of possession of untagged deer meat and being drunk on a public highway.

A fourth man, Verlin Roger Whittaker, 26, of 1063 Court st., pleaded guilty to charges of driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor and possession of untagged deer meat.

Whittaker was fined \$225, had his driver's license suspended for 90 days and received a suspended sentence of 30 days in jail for driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor. He was fined \$40 for possession of untagged deer meat.

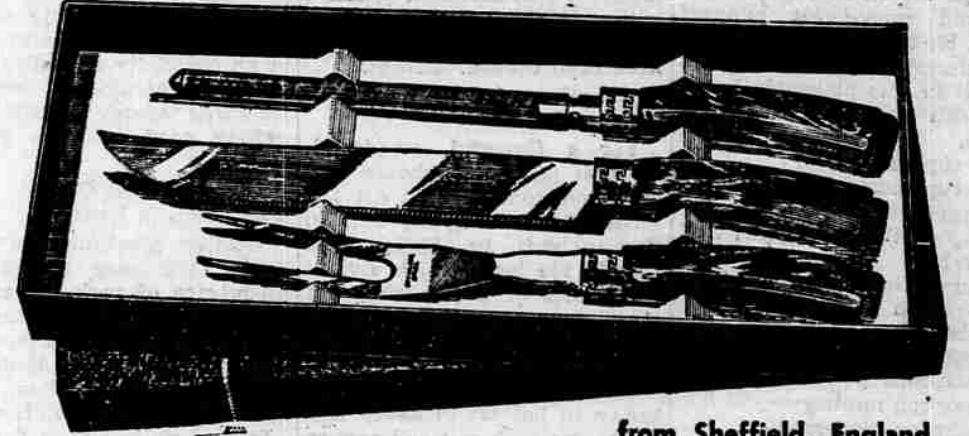

On the charge of illegal possession of deer meat they were each fined \$40. Nelson and Taylor's fines were suspended on the latter charge.

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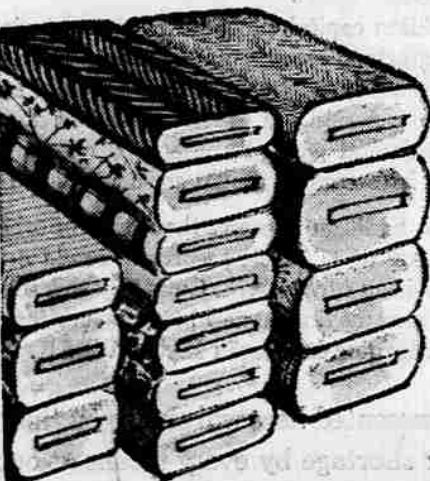


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
